WÁNG

king; ruler

THREE horizontal planes (三) representing heaven, man and earth, connected by a vertical structure (丨), form the character for king: 王 — the one vested with power, between heaven and earth, to rule uprightly over man. Originally 王 was a pictograph of a string of jade beads (王) which only the royalty could afford. It eventually became the symbol for king.

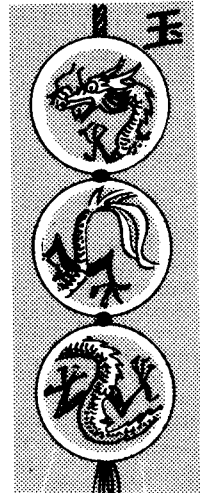

三 represents 3 pieces of jade strung together as a symbol for king: 王. The dot (丶) was added to form 玉 (jade), distinguishing it from 王 (king). Highly valued as a symbol of excellence and purity, jade may be found in its crude form, hidden in rough stone. Hence the saying: "Jade which is not chiselled and polished is not an article of beauty."

GUÓ country; nation

國 is composed of 囗 (boundary), 一 (land), 口 (mouth) and 戈 (spear). 國 therefore means land, people and weapons within a boundary — a country. The simplified form puts only 玉 (jade, representing king) within the boundary (口) to produce nation: 国. But a king needs subjects as much as subjects need food: “People are the nation’s source; food is the primary need of the people.”

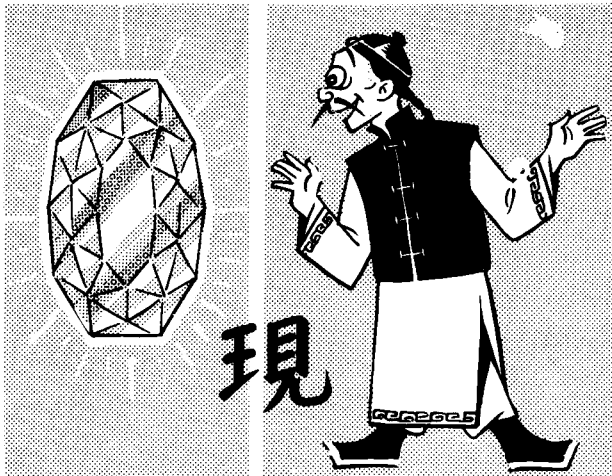

THE radical is 玉 (jade, gem) contracted to 王. The phonetic 見, representing eyes (目) of man (儿), means to see. So 现 means the sight of a sparkling gem, its appearance at that very moment; now. Appearances may be revealing or deceptive. According to the saying: "Fine words and appearance are seldom associated with virtue."

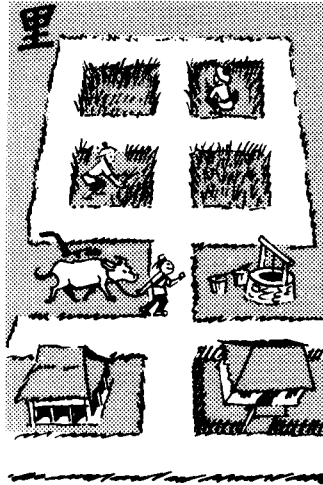

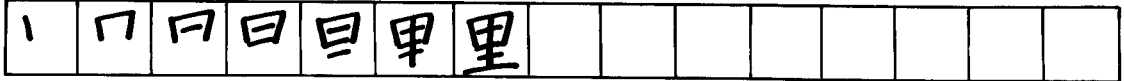

里 originally was a village made up of 田 (fields) and 土 (earth). The average length of one side, about 600 metres, became a measure of length: 里, a Chinese mile. 里 is also the simplified form of 裏. Here the radical for clothes (衣) is split and lined inside with the phonetic 里 to suggest inside: 裏.

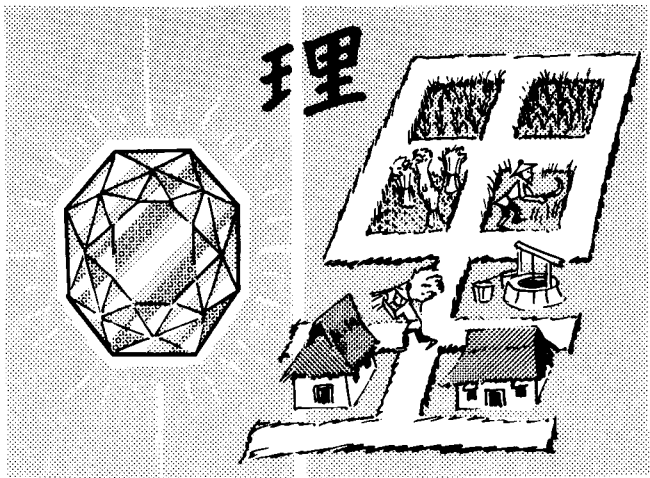

玉 (gem) is the radical, and the phonetic 里 is made up of 田 (field) and 土 (land). 理 compares the cutting of a gem to the dividing of field and land, both done according to fixed rules and principles; hence the extended meaning: reason, principle. The old saying highlights the importance of a moral standard: "A man of talent without principle is inferior to a simpleton with principle."

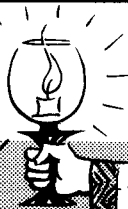

主 is a pictograph of a lampstand with the flame rising above it. It symbolises a man who spreads light — a lord or master. To shed light, the master himself needs the enlightening counsel: "If you suspect a man, don't employ him; if you employ a man, don't suspect him."

人 (man) is combined with 主 (master) to form 住, meaning to dwell. In ancient days, the man (人) was always master (主) of his dwelling; so the combination 住 suggests to dwell, to stay. In modern times, however, some husbands still boss the house; others house the boss.

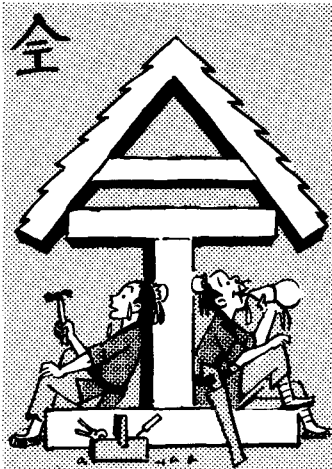

THIS character was first written 全 or 𠄎, combining 人 (joined) with 工 (work). It means completed, i.e., the components are assembled and the work finished. However, the modern character, classified under 人 (in), could be interpreted as a jade (王 or 玉) skilfully inlaid (入), and so flawless and perfect: 全. But perfection is not always the crucial thing: "Better an imperfect jade than a perfect tile."

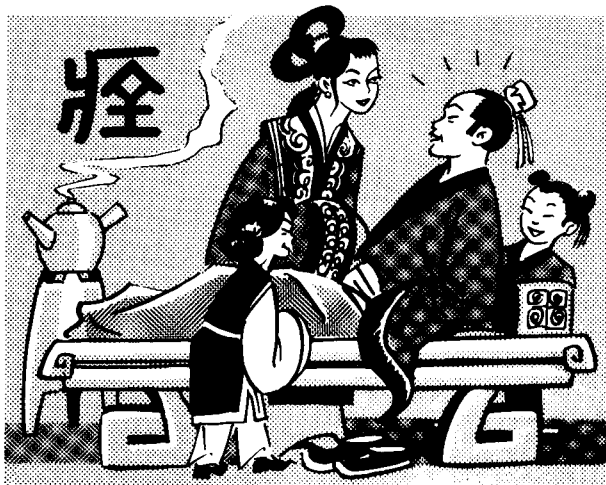

THE radical 疒 (originally 疒) represents a sick patient lying down (一) on a bed (月). The phonetic 全 means finished or completed. The combination 痊 is based on the belief of physicians that when a disease (疒) has run its full course (全), the patient recovers: 痊.

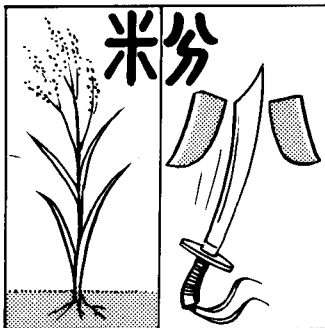

FACE powder in China was once made by grinding rice into fine particles. Hence the ideograph: 粉 meaning face powder – from 米 (rice) and 分 (divide, grind). The radical 米 is a likeness of a rice stalk and the phonetic 分 is a picture of a knife severing an object. 粉 now stands for anything ground into powder.

飯, the character for cooked rice, comes from the radical 食 (food) and the phonetic 反 meaning return. 反 represents the repetitive motion (了) of the hand (又), as in eating (食). Although hungry people are not fastidious about food, "One speck of rat's dung spoils a whole pot of rice." In combination, 食 is simplified to 饣.

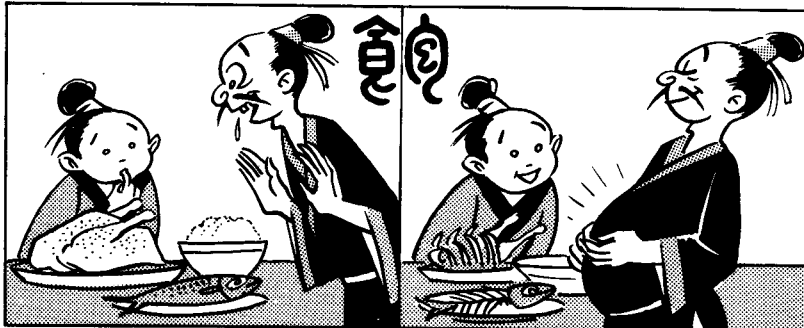

Bǎo eat to the full

包 the phonetic combines with 食, the radical for food, to form 飽 (satiated). The seal form of 包 is 𠔁, depicting a foetus enclosed in the body; hence the meaning wrapped up. 飽 therefore means food all wrapped up in the stomach, i.e., fully satisfied. However, as the saying goes: "Better be hungry and pure than well-filled and corrupt."

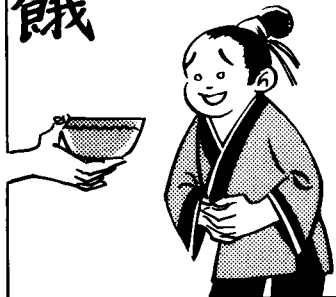

饿 (餓)

THIS character is based on the radical for food: 食. It literally means feed (食) me (我) — a fitting sign for hunger. Another character for hunger is 餓, literally: little (幾) food (食), simplified to 饥, i.e., food (斤) on small table (几). Although hunger is no respecter of persons, “Even a hungry person will refuse food offered in contempt.”

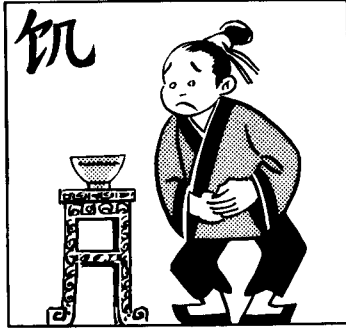

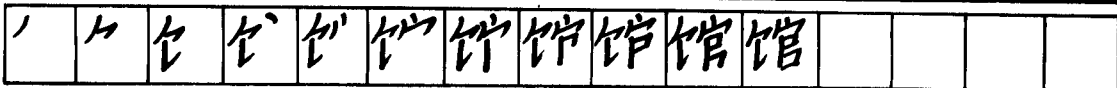
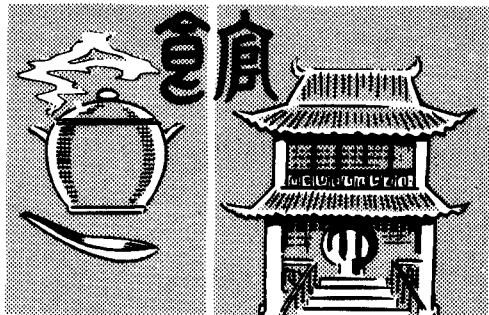

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馆 (館)

THE food radical 食 combines with 官 to produce 馆, a public building. The phonetic '官 (official) originally meant the residence of an official — the hall (山) of the city (官). 食 (food) together with '官 suggests a public building doing food business — inn, hotel or restaurant. Hence: "An innkeeper never worries if your appetite is big."

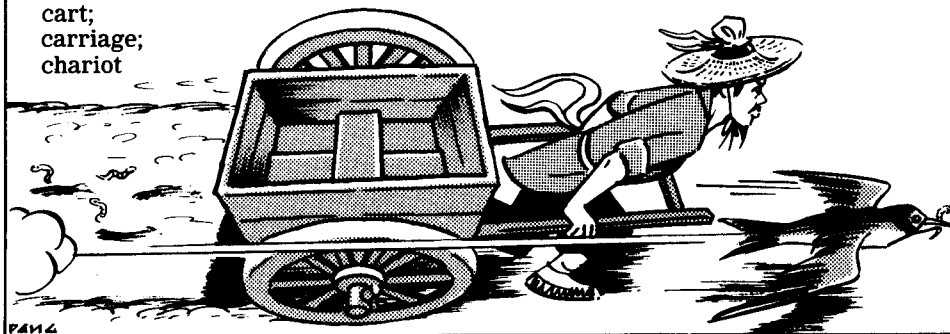

車 represents a bird's eye view of a cart, showing its body (日), the two wheels (二) and the axle (丨). The primitive forms of 車 are as varied as carts, carriages and chariots. But, whatever the form, where there is a cart in front there is a track behind; so "Take warning from the wrecked cart ahead of you."

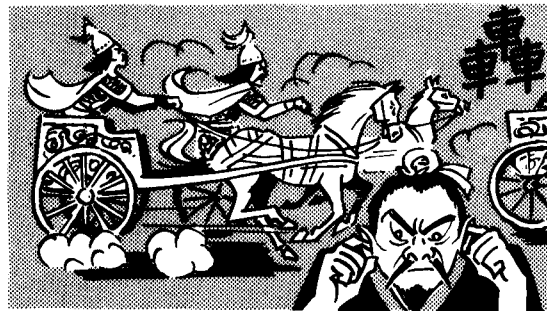

轰 (轟)

轰 is the triple form of the noisy cart (車). It serves as a fitting symbol for any loud or explosive sound like the rumbling of many carts. In the simplified form, 又 (again; ditto) replaces each of the two lower carts to produce 轰. 又 itself is a simplified picture of the right hand; and the right hand, returning repeatedly to the mouth in eating, suggests "again".

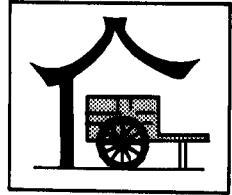

JUST as 宀 is a picture of a roof, representing hut, so 广 is half a hut — a shed or shop with an open front. 庫 originally was a shed (广) for carts (車). But, before long, it came to be used for storing grain and all sorts of goods. Hence 庫: a storehouse, warehouse, granary or depot.

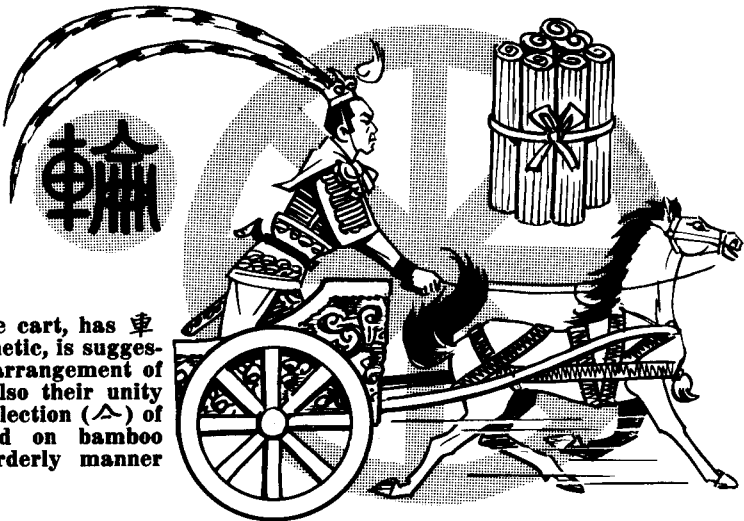

車輪, the wheel that moves the cart, has 車 (cart) for radical. 命, its phonetic, is suggestive, not only of the orderly arrangement of the spokes of a wheel, but also their unity and stability. It signifies a collection (△) of ancient documents preserved on bamboo slips tied together in an orderly manner (冊).

斩 (斬)

ZHǎN chop off

斩 probably has reference to a war chariot (車) with warriors wielding axes (斤) to cut off the enemy. It may also mean to whirl or brandish (揮) a battle axe (斤). But cutting off an enemy does not eradicate the source of trouble; hence the saying: "When cutting the weeds, get rid of the root" (斩草除根).

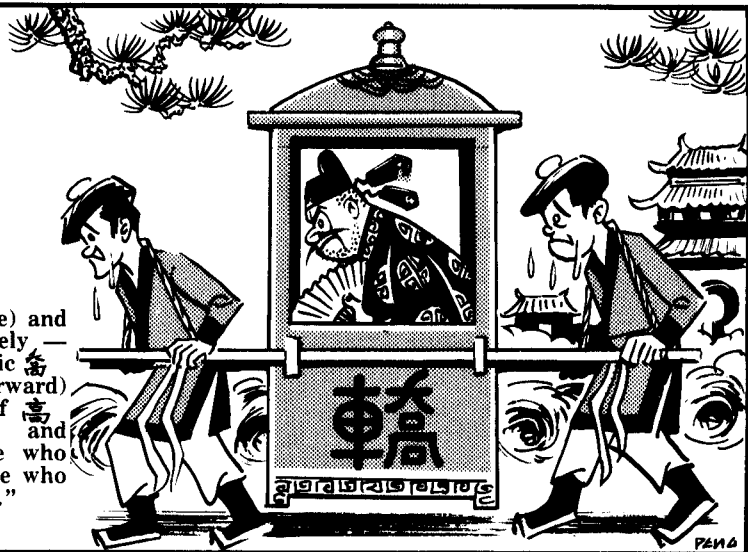

轿 is composed of 車 (vehicle) and 高, something high and stately — the sedan chair. The phonetic 高 combines 亻 (man leaning forward) with a contracted form of 高 (high). Although the high and mighty travel in sedans, "He who rides in the chair is a man; he who carries the chair is also a man."

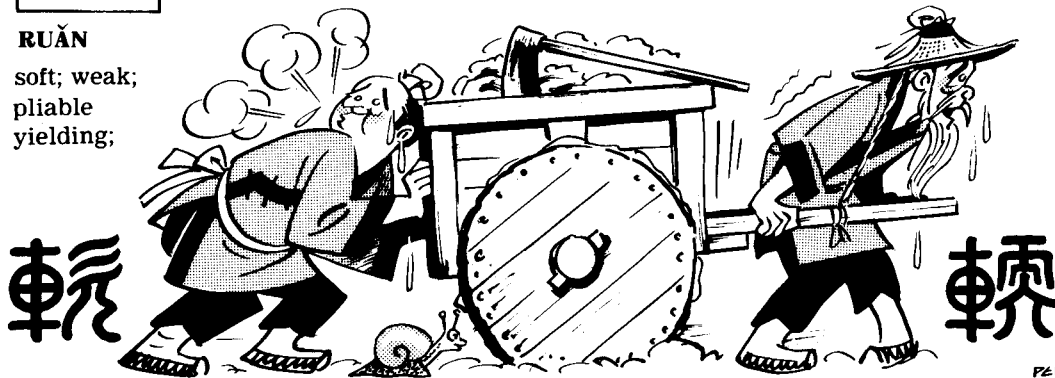

THE mobility of the carriage (車) is used to good effect in this character. Combined with 欠, it produces 軟, meaning soft and weak or pliable and flexible, 欠 signifying a man (儿) gasping for breath (乏), i.e., exhausted, deficient. 軟 may also be written 軟, the phonetic 欠 representing the soft beard (而) of a man (大).

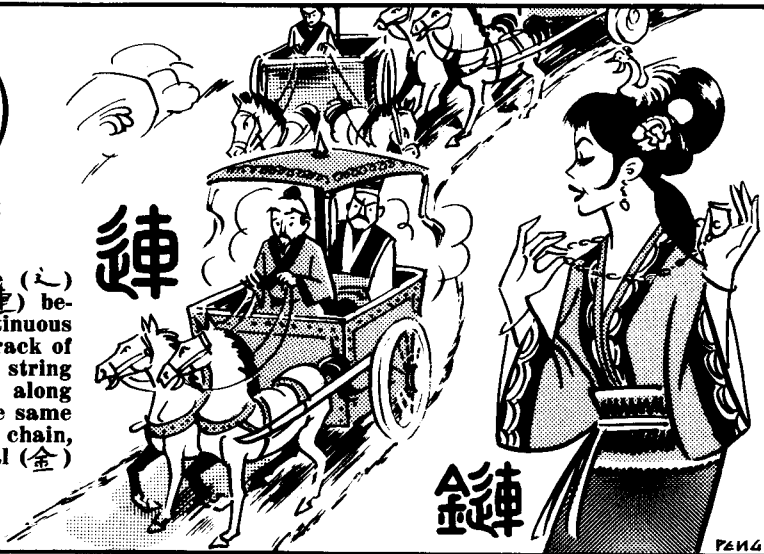

CARTS (車) on the move (之) form a connecting link (連) between places, leaving a continuous track, not broken like the track of man. 連 also represents a string of carriages (車) moving along (之) as if connected. By the same token 鏈, the character for chain, is made up of rings of metal (金) linked (連) together.

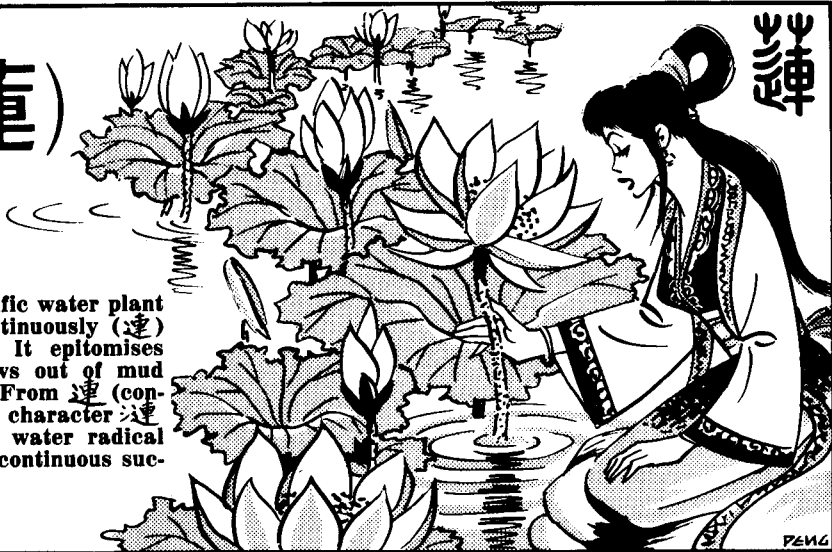

蓮 the lotus, is a prolific water plant (艹) that spreads continuously (連) like a flowery chain. It epitomises purity because it grows out of mud but remains undefiled. From 連 (connect) also comes the character 漣 (ripples) based on the water radical 氵 - ripples being a continuous succession (連) of waves.

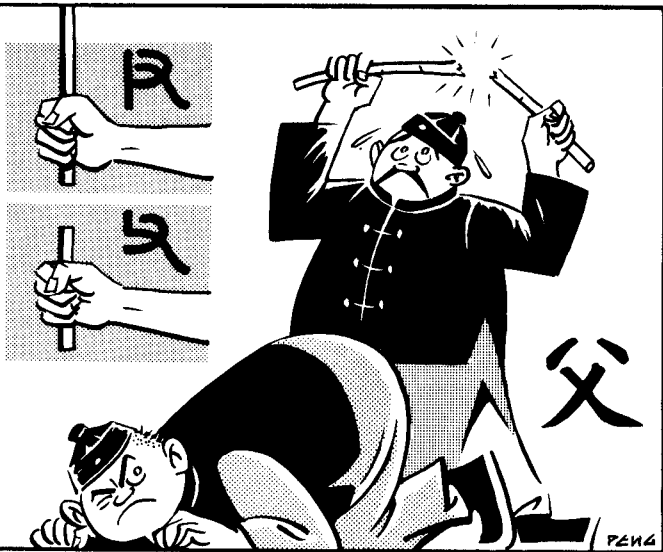

THE Chinese proverb defines father as “a man who, in praising his son, extols himself”. Accordingly, the seal form 𠤎 depicts father as a disciplinarian — the right hand (𠂇) wielding the rod of authority (丨). Eventually the rod is contracted: 𠂇 and then broken: 父. Apparently: “It is easy to govern a kingdom but difficult to rule one’s family.”

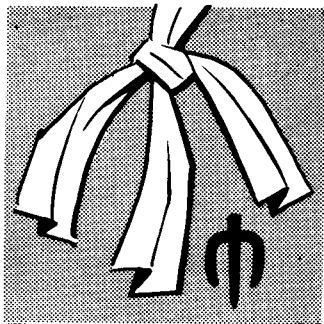

巾 is a pictograph of a small piece of cloth used for cleaning, dusting or wiping. In ancient times it was worn, suspended from the girdle. 冫 represents the two extremities of the cloth hanging (丨) from the girdle. 巾 forms the radical of a series of characters relating to cloth in general.

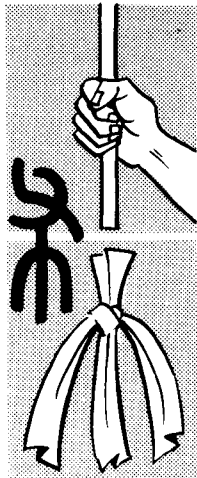

THIS character is based on the radical for cloth: 巾. The phonetic 父 (father) is discernible as 父 in the seal form 𠄎. 父 is a picture of the right hand (父) with the rod of authority (丨), and implies discipline, control and order – as essential in weaving as in marrying. So the saying goes: “Hasty weaving produces shoddy cloth; a girl who marries in haste has a fool for a husband.”

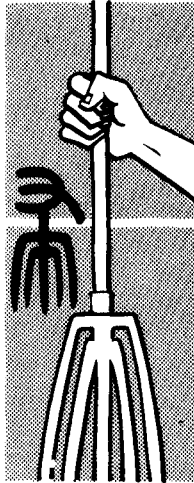

IN the seal form 帚, broom is suggested by a hand (又) with an improvised broom (𠂔) — double cloth (巾) attached to a handle (丨). Although a helping hand (才) can easily turn 帚 (broom) into 掃 (sweep), “no one will sweep a public hall used by everyone.”

As a memory aid, 船 could refer to a boat (舟) with eight (八) survivors or mouths (口) — an allusion to Noah's Ark. The radical 舟 is a picture of a boat. The phonetic 舟 probably means a coast; so 舟 is a coastal (之舟) vessel (舟). No matter how useful such a vessel is, "Like a thread without a needle, a boat is useless without water."

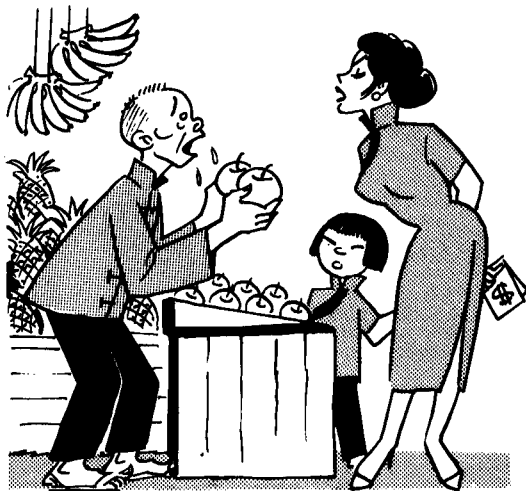

Then it was altered to 圓, being reclarified and surrounded by 口. Although hollowed out to 圆, the dollar is still changeable; it's easier to change dollars into goods than goods into dollars!

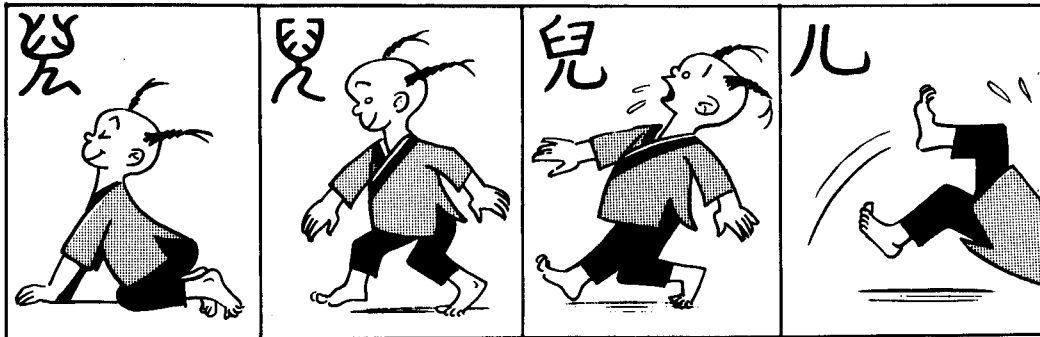

儿 is a pictograph of the growing child — from the crawling infant with open fontanels (兒) to the little toddler (兒) with wobbly legs, now simplified to its present form: 儿. The loving care shown in the delineation of this character calls to mind the saying: "To understand your parents' love, raise your own children."

話, meaning words or speech, is signified by words (言) of the tongue (舌).

講, meaning to speak or explain, is suggested by words (言) set in order (講), 講 being a graphic representation of the framework of a building. 講 is simplified to 讲. Sense is often linked with speech: "The full teapot makes no sound; the half-empty teapot makes much noise."

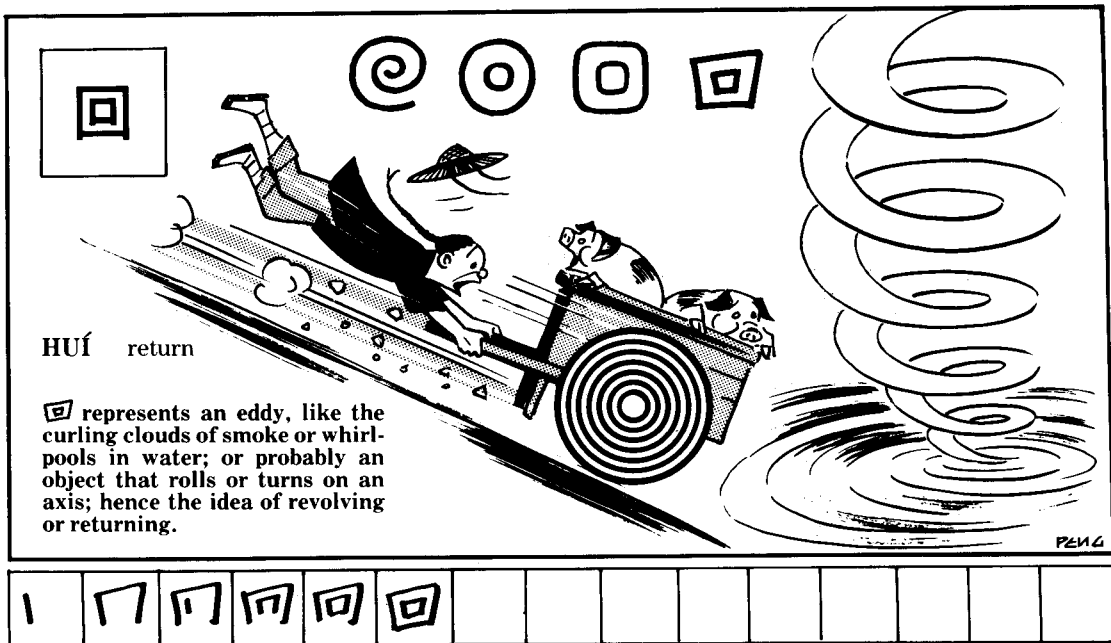

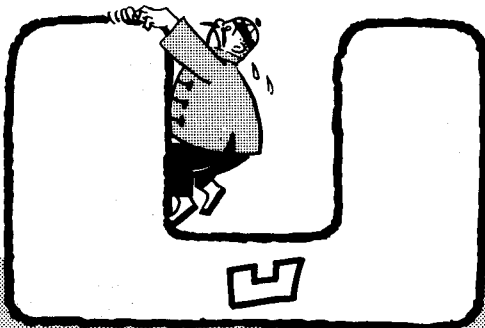

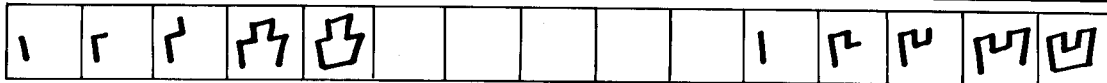
