### Announcing the Sixth World Meeting on Pharmaceutics, Biopharmaceutics and Pharmaceutical Technology

#### April 7–10, 2008 Barcelona, Spain

The APV (German “International Association for Pharmaceutical Technology”) and the APGI (French “Association for Industrial Pharmaceutical Technology”) have jointly organized the sixth World Meeting on Pharmaceutics, Biopharmaceutics and Pharmaceutical Technology in Barcelona, Spain, April 7–10, 2008. Other participating pharmaceutical societies include: the ADRIELF (Italy); AEFI (Spain); SAPS (Sweden); APSA (Australia); BSPS (Belgium); CPS (Czech Republic); EAPB (Germany); EPS (Estonia); FPS (Finland); GSIA (Switzerland); HSPTS (Hungary); PPS (Poland); SEFIG (Spain); SFD (Slovenia); TÜFTAD (Turkey); and VDI (Germany).

The Pharmaceutics, Biopharmaceutics and Pharmaceutical Technology World Meeting will be the largest Pharmaceutical Sciences congress in Europe this year. Nearly 1,000 abstracts have been

submitted, a new record. Around 1,500 participants are expected and a large variety of exhibitors will be present.

Symposia include: *Quality by Design—The Way Forward*; *PAT—Challenges and Applications*; *Formulation of Poorly Soluble and Permeable Drugs*; *Pre-formulation and New Excipients*; *Poly-morphism and Amorphous Systems—Design and Characterization*; and *Biogenerics—Bioequivalent or Biosimilar?* The meeting will help bridge the gap between fundamental academic research and industrial applications, offering the opportunity to initiate fruitful collaboration between universities and industry.

Barcelona is a cosmopolitan Mediterranean city. Its unique culture, lively Southern European lifestyle and beautiful beaches, monuments and architecture, excellent restaurants and cozy bars make Barcelona one of Europe’s top tourist destinations.
