


The End-User Interface

Comprehensive Search

AIAA eBooks allows full-text searching, including a search within a specific title and a search of all content on the site. Keywords included in the metadata are fully searchable.

Unsubscribed Content in Search Results

To enrich the user experience, the search results of AIAA eBooks include both subscribed and unsubscribed books. This makes it easier for users to find what they are looking for irrespective of its availability in their library. Users can view some pages of unsubscribed books as well as make notes on these. In addition, because the full text is indexed and searchable within a book or the entire site, every occurrence of a keyword is searchable. AIAA eBooks also supports advanced search based on several criteria, including author, publication year, and ISBN.

Multiple Concurrent User Access

Multiple library users can access the subscribed content at the same time. AIAA eBook packages are available for 2, 5, and 10 concurrent users. These users can make and save their personalized notes on the same content at the same time using their login information.

Notes

AIAA eBooks allows the user to make notes on the page-level on both subscribed and unsubscribed content. Multiple users can make notes on the same content at the same time and save them for access at a later date. Users are provided with a text editor so that they can format their notes, and these are made accessible from various convenient places like My Notes in the header, the My Account page, and the Notes icon in the reader.

RSS

RSS feeds keep users up to date with our new content. Users can choose their favorite subject categories and be notified whenever new titles are added to these categories. RSS feeds can be used by both guests and authenticated users. They are delivered in an automated manner without using any personal information like e-mail addresses.

Featured Title

Your authorized administrator or AIAA can show a Featured Title on the homepage. The Featured Title—a book to which your institution has subscribed—can be changed frequently.

Recommend to your Librarian

AIAA eBooks users can search for all books, irrespective of whether their library has subscribed to them or not. If users would like certain books to be added to their library repositories, they can recommend them to their librarians by completing a simple form.

Citations

The citation tool makes it easy for readers to view and export citations, providing a valuable tool for academic referencing and research.

Browse Box

AIAA eBooks includes a prominently placed Browse Box, allowing the user to easily navigate through subject categories or to review special categories of content, including New Releases, Best Sellers, and Featured Titles.

Favorite Books

AlAA eBooks allows users to maintain a list of their favorite books online, including unsubscribed titles. They can use their login information to save this list for future reference. If subscribed, the books are readable online. If unsubscribed, they are only available for a limited view.

E-mail Alerts

Now, it's easy for AIAA eBooks users to remain updated about books in their favorite subject areas. Users can subscribe to the notification service that provides information about new and updated titles in their chosen subject categories on a weekly basis.



Library Administration Tool — Manage Your Account

Assign Roles

The library administration tool (Content Manager) allows you to assign different access rights to different people based on their roles. This allows institutions to manage work more efficiently, by allowing limited access to some administrators and complete access to others.

Managing IP Addresses

The Content Manager lets library administration users view, edit, update, delete, and label their IP addresses, all in the same user interface. Once IP addresses are added, edited, or deleted, an activation request is sent immediately to your sales representative who will activate the account.

Managing Institutional Details

The Content Manager allows the library administration users to manage all their institutional details, including contact person details, billing address, and branding options like display of their library logo on the end-user interface.

Managing Individual Library Accounts

All library administration users, irrespective of their roles, can use the same interface for managing their own accounts. The content manger lets them edit their account details as well as subscribe to e-mail alerts to stay up to date on new content.

Managing Other Users' Accounts

The primary institutional library administrator can not only manage his or her own account view, but can also manage the account of all other library users for the institution, by activating or deactivating other users, changing their login information, or deleting users.

View Subscriptions

The Content Manager lets library administration users view all of their subscribed AIAA eBook packages. It also allows them to view information about all available (unsubscribed) packages. They can choose new packages from those available and place requests using a single interface.

Advertisements on the Dashboard


The Content Manager allows AIAA to keep library administration users informed of new content, offers, discounts, etc., with advertisements displayed on the library administration user dashboard.

Featured Title

Library administration users can add "Featured Titles" to the end-user interface. This allows the library administration user to keep their constituency informed of new material and helps to keep their homepage looking fresh.

Contacting AIAA

The Content Manager is the interface through which the library administration users can make new purchase requests, communicate problems, queries, and feedback. A separate section of the content manager ensures that AIAA will receive all of their requests.
