
And there is no better charitable time, than this month; December

YOUR ANSWERS TO THOSE EVERYDAY BEAUTY QUESTIONS YOU'VE ALWAYS WANTED TO ASK.

With winter just around the corner, even in a country like Qatar, where temperatures don't often drop below 15°C, our body and skin tend to tell us they feel the effects of the weather changing. We may experience extra dryness, unusual breakouts, or lack of radiance. It is therefore crucial to give our skin some extra TLC at this time of year. As we say goodbye to our beach and suntan weekends, figuring out what colours and makeup products compliment our 'paler', winter complexion can get tricky. Here are some answers to the most frequent questions and concerns regarding beauty and makeup as we enter the heart of winter season in Doha.

HOW DO I TREAT THE NEWLY FORMED PIMPLES ON MY FACE AFTER SUMMER IS OVER?

Start by a disciplined 'rehabilitation'
• skin care regimen. Exfoliating, deep cleansing, and proper hydration are key to achieve that.

Investing in the right products that are suitable for your skin type and needs is essential. A lot of brands nowadays make multi tasking products such as exfoliating washes that are gentle enough for every day use or 2-in-1 cleansers and facial masks. (Clarins One-Step Gentle Exfoliating Cleanser is mild enough for dry skin, while Demalogica's Daily Microfoliant is super skin friendly. As for oily skin, I give Sensai's Silky Purifying Mud Soap a 10/10).

For a deeper scrub, I would recommend using your facial wash and exfoliator with the Clarisonic (up to twice a week for oily skin, and every 10 days or fortnight for dry skin).

Once your skin is rid of all these radicals, it is time to hydrate it properly. I always recommend a good serum paired with a moisturizer, to be used twice a day, on a bare clean face.

HOW DO I AVOID LOOKING TOO PALE AND PASTY IN WINTER?

Luckily, this winter's trend when it comes to
complexion is all about the sporty natural look.

Begin by applying a BB cream, or a tinted moisturizer or a light weight foundation to even out your skin tone.

A light reflecting concealer should provide a fresh and dewy under eye area, while a fine translucent powder can set this makeup in place without weighing down your skin.

When it comes to giving your face some colour, use bronzer in the reverse way of contouring, i.e. dust a bronzer or a powder a couple of shades darker than your skin tone on the high points of the face (forehead, apples of your cheeks, a little on the nose as well) to give your skin a flushed sun kissed look. Dust some highlighting powder or dab a little bit of liquid or cream highlighter on top of your cheekbones. Finish off with a cream blusher dabbed softly on the cheeks. This will

give you a flushed and fresh complexion that is sure to keep you looking awake and alive!

HOW DO I WEAR GLITTER ON MY EYES WITHOUT LOOKING LIKE A DISCO BALL THIS FESTIVE SEASON?

Before applying glitter, It is always wise to use an eyeshadow that is the same colour as the glitter you will use. This will act as the base colour that will blend better with the glitter and give a more even appearance to the colour applied on the lid. If you are using loose glitter, it is crucial to use the proper glitter base, which will keep the glitter firmly stuck on your eyelid (and it will prevent it falling on your cheeks later in the evening). Lit Cosmetics Clearly Liquid Glitter Base is the one that I find does the job best.

Also, applying glitter on one area of the eye can look subtle and elegant. Opt for one of the following for glitter placement: inner corner of the eye, inner half of the upper lid, liquid glitter liner on the top lashline OR bottom lashline.

HOW DO I WEAR BOLD MAKEUP COLOURS IN WINTER?

First, you should always distinguish between colours you can pull off of during the day or at the office, and what you can wear on a night out.

For day time, you cannot go wrong with gold, shimmery taupes, bronzes and medium browns. You can always opt for a subtle lilac or lavender purple, some pastel blues and greens, applied as a wash of colour on the lid. If you are more on the classic side, you can pair up a subtle brown smokey eye with a green, a navy blue or a metallic grey kohl on the waterline. A soft eye makeup with a bold lip, even in day time, can look very sophisticated and trendy. I like to call that the 'statement minimalistic look'.

At night, you can afford to go more deep and bold with some vibrant greens, coppers, rich jewel tones on the eyes, applied with a heavier hand this time, paired with cranberries, deep reds and purples on the lips.

Step 3: Indian Sun technique was applied to her hair to give soft low-lights. And for the final touches to her face, I illuminated her skin and provided her with neutral pink lips to balance out the whole look. •TIP: Use neutral colours for lips and cheeks so that your eyes remain the main focal point.



SPLIT LEG SQUAT

Stand in front of an exercise bench, facing away from it. Extend one leg backwards to rest your foot on the top of the bench. Lower your hips by slowly bending your knees. Continue until your front thigh is parallel to the ground. The front knee should not be bent so much that it goes past your toes.

WIDE SQUAT

Holding onto a dumbbell, allow arms to hang in front. Separate feet slightly wider than shoulder-width apart and turn out toes. Keeping chest lifted, lower into squat until your legs make a 90 degree angle, then return to starting position.









SIDE LUNGES

Stand with your feet about hip-width apart, hands on your waist. Take a giant step to the right, dropping your butt back (keep your knee from extending over your toes). Press back to start. Then repeat the move to the left.



JUMPING JACKS

Stand with your hands at your sides and your feet together. Jump up and spread your feet out as you simultaneously raise your arms above your head. Without pausing, jump back to the starting position.



TOE TOUCHES

Stand straight with the head forward and legs straight. Bend down and touch your toes with your fingers and reverse back to the original position.

CRISPY LUGAIMAT

INGREDIENTS

- > 1 ½ cup milk > 2 cups all-purpose flour > 1 tsp salt > 1 tbsp sugar
- > I tbsp yeast > I tbsp cornstarch > Little saffron

For decoration:

> Nigella seeds (black seeds) > Date molasses > Sesame

PROCEDURE

- 1) Using a wooden spoon, mix together all the ingredients until uniformly combined. Keep the batter aside to ferment and double in size.
- 2) Heat oil in a frying pan until hot. Drop the batter with a spoon into the oil in batches and fry, turning them on each side until golden brown and crisp.
- 3) Drizzle the date molasses over the Lugaimat, tossing to coat thoroughly, then sprinkle with sesame and Nigella.
- 4) Arrange the Lugaimat onto the serving dish and serve at once.

STUFFED TAMR WITH YOGURT AND NUTS

INGREDIENTS

- >1 lt. Laban
- > Pinch of salt
- > Soft dates (Tamr) with sesame and honey, pitted
- > Nuts, as desired
- > Decorative paper wrappers

PROCEDURE

- Pour the Laban in a large pot. Simmer over gentle heat for an hour or until small lumps are formed on the surface.
- 2) Remove the pot from heat and let cool completely.
- 3) Using a slotted spoon, remove the Yaget (milk lumps) gently from the Laban and place them in a plate.
- 4) Stuff the Tamr (soft dates) with yogurt and nuts. Wrap each piece with decorative papers, as preferred. Arrange the sweets in a serving tray.



Ratari desserts are normally enjoyed with a cup of coffee, known as gahwa helw. Translated as "sweet coffee", this hot beverage is injused with orange, saffron, cardamom, and sugar.

KHANFAROUSH AL-DOUGHNUTS

INGREDIENTS

> 1 ½ cups all-purpose flour > ¾ cup rice flour > 4 eggs > ½ cup sugar > 1 tsp vanilla > 1 tbsp baking powder > 1 small cup rose water soaked with saffron > 1 tbsp powdered cardamom > ½ cup oil > Pinch of salt

Icing:

- > 2 cups icing sugar > 1 tbsp milk > 1 tbsp lemon juice or vanilla > Food colours > Coloured sugar crystals or candy sprinkles, for
- **PROCEDURE**

decoration

- Using the electric mixer, beat together the eggs, sugar, vanilla, oil, cardamom and soaked rose water with saffron until incorporated fully.
- 2) Sift the two flours, the baking powder and pinch of salt together. Add the flours to the eggs and sugar mixture, beating continuously until homogeneous.
- 3) Let the batter rest, about 10 minutes.
- 4) Heat the doughnut maker until hot. Using a spoon, place spoonfuls of the batter into the doughnut maker holes. Close the lid and cook until done. Repeat the same process until all quantity has finished.
- 5) Next, prepare the icing.
- 6) In a deep bowl, place the icing sugar, vanilla, lemon and milk. Whisk together with a fork until thick and creamy.
- 7) Pour in drops of food colour and mix to combine well.
- 8) Dip the Khanfaroush into the icing to coat the top and then decorate with coloured sugar crystals. Serve cold.



- 1) Place the water, cardamom, saffron, rose water and sugar into a pot over heat. Bring the mixture to a boil.
- 2) Add the flour gradually, stirring vigorously over gentle heat until the mixture is coherent.



Chestnuts commonly spark thoughts of the holiday season and sitting by an open fire. These tree nuts are highly rated as a cookery ingredient and rightly so: beautiful, shiny and wonderfully versatile; despite what the name may suggest, chestnuts are equally at home in

sweet or savoury dishes.



ABOUT CHESTNUTS Unlike other nuts and seeds, chestnuts are relatively low in calories; contain less fat but are rich in minerals, vitamins and packed highly in nutrients that benefit health.

PAN FRIED SEA **BASS WITH** CHESTNUT PUREE, WILTED SPINACH AND **MEDITERRANEAN** SALSA

INGREDIENTS

Pan Fried Sea Bass > Sea Bass 1 Fillet (180 gm.) > Sea Salt 1 tsp > Olive Oil 1 tbsp > Flour 1 tsp > Black Pepper Crushed ½ tsp

Chestnut Puree > Chestnut, Roasted ½ Cup > Onion Sliced 1/2 Cup > Butter 1 tbsp > Chicken Stock I Cup > Salt ½ tsp > Pepper ½ tsp

Wilted Spinach > Spinach | Cup > Garlic Chopped 1 Clove > Butter 1 Tbsp > Salt ½ tsp > Pepper ½ tsp

Mediterranean Salsa > Black Olives, pitted and diced 1/3 Cup > Tomato, Seeded and Chopped 1 > Onion, Chopped 1 > Fresh Basil Leaves, Julliene Itbsp > Drained Capers I tbsp > Freshly Grated Orange Zest 1/2 tsp > Fresh Lemon Juice 1 tsp > Olive Oil 2 tbsp > Salt ½ tsp > Pepper ½ tsp



PROCEDURE

Sea Bass 1) In the nonstick pan heat the olive oil over medium heat. 2) Season fish with salt and pepper, dust with flour. Cook it on the pan, first skin side down, till golden brown. 4) Now turn on to the other side and cook through.

Chestnut Puree 1) Sauté the onion with butter till onion get translucent. 2) Add in the chestnut and chicken stock and cook it till chestnut get soft. 3) Blend it to make a puree, season with salt and pepper.

Wilted Spinach 1) Sauté the garlic with butter. 2) Add in the spinach, sauté it, season with salt and pepper

Mediterranean Salsa I) In a bowl stir together olives, tomato, shallot, basil julienne, capers, zest, lemon juice, and I tablespoon oil to make salsa and season with freshly ground black pepper and salt.

Plating Spoon the chestnut puree on plate, now add spinach on it. Place fish on the spinach, spooned the salsa on fish, garnish with a spring of basil.



SEARED FOIE GRAS WITH MARINATED APPLE, CHESTNUT CHANTILLY AND PLUM SAUCE

INGREDIENTS

Seared Foie Gras > Foie Gras 3 Slices > Sea Salt 1 tsp > Brioche Bread 3 Small Slices

Plum Sauce > Plum 4 pcs. > Cinnamon Stick ⅓ of Stick > Lemon Zest 1 tsp > Water 1 Cup > Salt pinch

Marinated Apple > Green Apple ½ Pc. > Lemon Juice 1 tsp > Wasabi ½ tsp > Olive oil 1 tsp

Caramelized Chestnut > Chestnut 4 Pcs. > Sugar 2 tbsp > Water 1 tbsp

Chestnut Puree > Chestnut, Roasted ½ Cup > Onion Sliced ½ Cup > Butter I tbsp > Chicken Stock I Cup > Salt ½ tsp > Pepper ½ tsp

Chestnut Chantilly > Whipped Cream 4 tbsp > Chestnut Puree 8 tbsp

PROCEDURE

Seared Foie Gras 1) Make cross marks on the foie gras. Sear on the non-stick pan till it is a golden brown colour both sides. Season it with sea salt.

Plum Sauce 1) Deseed the plum, add with water in a pan, and add cinnamon stick and lemon zest. 2) Cook it on the very slow flame or in the oven at 140 degree C for 25 minutes. 3) After cooking take out the cinnamon stick, blend it and strain.

Caramelized Chestnut 1) Boil the water and sugar together and cook it till it becomes a golden brown colour. 2) Coat the Chestnut with Sugar caramel.

Marinated Apple 1) Make small balls from the green apple. Marinate with Lemon Juice, Olive oil and Wasabi.

Chestnut Puree 1) Sauté the onion with butter till onion becomes translucent.2) Add in the chestnut and chicken stock and cook it till chestnut get soft.

Blend it to make a puree, season with salt and pepper.

Chestnut Chantilly 1) Whip the cream, fold it with chestnut puree.

Plating Arrange brioche bread on the plate, now foie gras on the bread, spoon plum sauce between each foie gras, add apple balls and quenelle of chantilly on the sauce. Sprinkle the caramelized chestnut.



CHESTNUT PANNA COTTA WITH POACHED PEARS

INGREDIENTS

Poached Pears > Sugar 1 Cup > Raspberry Juice ½
Cup > Vanilla Bean, Split lengthways 1 > Orange Rind 1
tbsp > Pear 4 Pcs.

Chestnut Panacotta > Cream 1.5 Cup > Milk ½ cup > Sweetened Chestnut Puree ½ Cup > Vanilla Bean, Split lengthways 1 > Gelatin2 Leaves

PROCEDURE

Chestnut panna cotta

- Combine cream, milk, chestnut puree and scraped seeds from vanilla bean and bean in a saucepan, bring to boil, and then remove from the heat.
- 2) Soak gelatin leaves in cold water for 2-3 minutes or until soft, drain, then squeeze out excess water and add to milk mixture.

3) Strain mixture through a fine sieve into a jug, cool to room temperature, then divide among 4 molds and refrigerate for 4 hours or overnight.

Poached Pears

- 1) Place sugar, juice, scraped vanilla bean seeds and bean, cinnamon, orange rind and 2 cups water in a large saucepan and stir over low heat until sugar dissolves, then remove from heat and stand until completely cool.
- 2) Add pears to cooled syrup, cover with a round of baking paper and place a saucer on top to keep pear submerged during cooking, then bring to the boil over medium heat, reduce heat to low and simmer for 8 minutes.
- 3) Remove pan from heat, stand pears in liquid until tender, and cool to room temperature. Remove orange rind from poaching liquid, thinly slice, then place in a small saucepan with I cup poaching liquid and simmer over low heat for IO minutes or until syrupy, then cool.

Platting Dip panna cottta briefly in hot water, invert onto plate, then serve with poached pears, a little syrup.




HAYA AL-KUWARI



MUSIC LET'S ME BE ME!


When we asked a group of children why they like music, one six-year-old girl shouted, "Music let's me be me!"

ach month we welcome families to JALC Doha to stomp, strut and swing to the joyous rhythms of jazz. It's similar to JALC NYC's 'We-Bop,' and in Doha we call it 'Afternoon Tea' which is an early childhood jazz programme that gives children a creative outlet to explore jazz through movement, songs, storytelling and play. For us, it's one of the most fulfilling moments of being out here in Doha. We get to see children express themselves in their own individual way through music. Children tend to have great improvisation skills and creativity, and it's through these sessions where we try to capture and nurture this.

Wynton Marsalis explains it perfectly:
"Through improvisation, jazz teaches
you about yourself. And through swing
(rhythm), it teaches you that other
people are individuals too. It teaches you
how to coordinate with them."

Having dedicated his life to education, Wynton has inspired an entire generation of jazz musicians who have a real passion for teaching. Almost every jazz musician my age I know has a 'Wynton Story,' where he visited their school while on tour, inspiring them in some significant way. When I was fifteen he came to my hometown and invited me backstage to play a song for him. He ended up spending two hours working with me, giving suggestions on practice techniques, and later on came to my gig and played music with us all night. As I got older I began to appreciate the time he spent with me that very day. I thought to myself, "this is one of the most accomplished musicians in the world, yet he is so accessible and generous to young players." Over the





years I have learned that this sincere sense of care and passion for sharing music with kids is a part of the long tradition of jazz. Jazz music is rooted in some of the most basic human qualities, and education and 'passing on the tradition' are part of its inherent makeup. On a recent trip to Abu Dhabi through our Journeys with Jazz Festival we had the privilege of working with a group of young local musicians that took the time to teach us their music. A 12-year old girl brought her Kanoon to play. Excited to teach us a traditional song from her culture, she played the song and improvised effortlessly with a big smile, and then went note by note waiting for us to learn what she was playing! Another girl came up to the piano and played a song she just composed. We learned her song right away and all began playing it together,

finding harmony notes and different rhythms to support her. Soon every child in the room took their instrument out and began trying to learn the song too. Finally everyone joined in playing, and there were groups breaking into sections to find a supporting role to play. While totally unexpected, it exemplified spontaneity, teamwork, confidence, respect and a real sense of community, all through music.

The essence of improvisation, curiosity, respect and individuality reminds us how similar we are, and how important and rewarding it is to find a common ground between cultures. To have the opportunity to both share music with children and learn from them, helps to bring forward some of the most important characteristics that bring cultures and music together.
