an isolated AB_6 complex with symmetry $\bar{6}2m$ has its electrostatic optimum [$\mu = 51.6 (1)^{\circ}$].

The maximum α value of the structure type under consideration is not only definitely smaller than that of the NaCl type ($\alpha=1.7476$), but also slightly smaller than the maximum value for the NiAs type, i.e. $\alpha=1.733$ (1) as derived from the values given by Zemann (1958). It is, therefore, no surprise that the AB structure type with mutual trigonal prismatic coordination has no representatives among ionic structures.




Fig. 10. (a) 3-fold rotational symmetry, 2nd generation. (b) 6-fold rotational symmetry, 2nd generation.
