Finally, in 2010 the journal *Antiviral Research* celebrates 30 years of publication. To celebrate this anniversary, the Editors and the Publisher of the journal are delighted to announce an *Antivirals Congress* to be held in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, in November 2010.
