



IXecute (CLI ONLY)

This utility located in the TOASTER section can be used by anyone. It will allow you to execute script files from an ICON. But it does a little more than that. It also allows you to specify the directory you want to operate from (which is important when it comes to scripts).

SmartDisk Harddisk DiskCache

If you have a harddisk, then this utility is a must. It is a 512k sector cache and the sectors are prefetched. With this utility installed, your harddisk should be much faster than before when it comes to program load time and directory loads. Versions included for Xt, SCSI and GVP-SCSI drives.

Workbench2.0 Section

This is a utility that acts as a super-trashcan which adds an APPICON to the Workbench's "backdrop" window. Then, when you want to delete a file or a drawer, simply drag the item into the "Black Hole" and you will then be asked if you are sure. If you are, the item will be deleted forever.
