ABCDir

Although a directory utility on the Amiga wasn't a new idea, and there were several around, none of them were what directory utility should be. Some had power but lacked flexibility, others were flexible but forgot how to be intuitive, and still others were intuitive, flexible and powerful, but were spread over ten thousand screens and buttons. So here is ABCDirectory, an extremely powerful file manipulation utility under a simple and integrated roof. Some features include: It makes good use of those filenotes (comments). While the mouse moves over entries, their comments can be displayed on the error/info line. So comment all of your files & NEVER EVER be left wondering: -what's this file again?. An infinite number of uses can be extrapolated from the simple recognition system ABCDirectory uses which makes it very versatile. Treat LHA archives as if they were directories. It's simple to use and very functional, hence the ABC. Most of its gadgets are at the top of the display so you won't have to move your mouse up & down the screen like madman. No pixel is left to chance. It's QUICK!QUICK!QUICK! It has online help (file ABCDir.help) for its neat. It has a smart remembered and buffered dirs. It's intuitive as hell (or something in that vicinity). It has kling klang kabang kool scrolling (if you have the req.library installed of course...) The progress of commands that go into recursive directories can actually BE SEEN. This means that you don't only see the name of files being copied, but that you see the loaded directory with all the entries selected & then successively deselected & acted upon. ON DISK: Wow.

Amiga Real Time Monitor

Well, how would you like to see it ALL at a glance, all at the same time? If you need more memory, you can look through to see if there are strange libraries or fonts you may not need. You can easily remove them. ARTM displays and controls activities in your Amiga. It is full supported by Intuition and it is very easy to use. ARTM will display all the Tasks operating, and you can select or remove them. All open screens and Windows are also displayed. All libraries and versions are displayed. This way you can check to see if you have the latest versions running. Lets not forget all the devices and drive. You can control the priorities. Major features include: freely programmable command line editing, simple history, piping, aliases with arguments, variables & variable handling (embedded variables), file name expansion via wild carding ('?', '*' and more), conditionals (if/else etc..), source files (w/ gotos and labels), tab file name completion, object oriented features (file classes, actions), many built in commands to speed things up, and more. DiskEditor

Did you ever want to see what a program looks like before you load it into memory? You can see hidden messages, and unusual text entries. If it is a game, they could give you clues. Or if you are just curious about looking at, and learning about your floppy and hard drives, then this program will allow you to explore. This disk editor (nickname 'DED') allows you to: Edit sectors on disk in binary form or in DOS structures (including bitmap), Find file of FFS datablock, Scan for DOS structure references to any block, Edit rigid disk blocks in structure form, Export or import bytes from/to disk, All sectors are not written to the disk, but they are left in memory until you ask DED to write them. But if you change anything, ALL functions will access modified sectors in memory and not the original, ones on the disk - you may try to do anything without risking integrity of your disk. All menuitems have help, Built-in calculator, which you can use in every number gadget and more!
