## **Preface**

This issue of *Biogeochemistry* is devoted to publishing the proceedings of a workshop held in April of 1986 at the University of Georgia Marine Institute, Sapelo Island, Georgia, USA. David Coleman and Elaine Ingham organized the workshop to examine the interactions among element cycles in terrestrial ecosystems. The Ecosystem Studies Program of the US National Science Foundation supported the workshop through funding to the University of Georgia.
