Global Atmospheric-biospheric Chemistry: The First IGAC Scientific Conference

- Date:* Sunday, April 18 – Thursday, April 22, 1993
- Location:* Eilat (on the Red Sea Coast), Israel
- Purpose:* Review and presentation of new results in the area of Global Atmospheric Chemistry and its interactions with the Biosphere highlighting the early achievements of IGAC, which is a Core Project of the International Geosphere-Biosphere Program (IGBP).
Conference foci include regional studies (marine, tropical, mid-latitude, boreal, polar), global studies, and fundamental laboratory studies.
