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Papers will be considered for publication on all aspects of drug action, including chemotherapy.

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References are arranged according to the Harvard system, at the end of the paper in alphabetical order of the first author of each paper. They should include the authors' names, year of publication, title of article, title of publication (abbreviated in accordance with the fourth edition of the *World List of Scientific Periodicals*), volume number and first and last page number. References to books should, in addition, include the names of editors and edition number, where appropriate, town of origin and name of publisher.

Figures should not be larger than foolscap ($12\frac{1}{2}$ in. $\times$ 8 in.), and may be in the form of original drawings, recorded tracings or high quality photographs made from them. Good quality prints (black on white) are preferred to positive prints of kymograph tracings. Lettering should be inserted in pencil. Photographs and photomicrographs should be printed on glossy paper and should be larger than the size required for reproduction. Symbols which are to appear in the legend should be chosen from the following:

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
