Suggestions to Authors

A recent issue of the journal is a good guide to style. Papers are accepted only if accompanied by a statement that they have not and will not be published in whole or in part in any other journal.

Manuscripts should be typed in double spacing on one side only of quarto or foolscap paper, with a separate title page giving the names and addresses of the authors and a suggested short title. Tables and legends to figures should be on separate sheets of paper. A short summary of results and conclusions, arranged in numbered paragraphs, must be included, together with an abstract of about 100 words suitable for inclusion in *International Abstracts of Biological Sciences*.

References are arranged according to the Harvard system, at the end of the paper in alphabetical order of the first author of each paper. They should include the authors' names, year of publication, title of article, title of publication (abbreviated in accordance with the fourth edition of the *World List of Scientific Periodicals*), volume number and first and last page number. References to books should, in addition, include the names of editors and edition number, where appropriate, town of origin and name of publisher.

Figures should not be larger than foolscap ($12\frac{1}{2}$ in. $\times 8$ in.), and may be in the form of original drawings, recorded tracings or high quality photographs made from them. Good quality prints (black on white) are preferred to positive prints of kymograph tracings. Lettering should be inserted in pencil. Photographs and photomicrographs should be printed on glossy paper and should be larger than the size required for reproduction. Symbols which are to appear in the legend should be chosen from the following:



Two page proofs will be supplied, one of which may be retained by the authors. The other should be corrected immediately and returned to the Press Editor. Corrections should be kept to a minimum.

Fifty reprints will be supplied to authors free of charge. Additional reprints can be purchased. A reprint order form, which should be returned promptly, will be sent out with the proofs.
