New Avenues in Developmental Cancer Chemotherapy The Eighth Annual Bristol-Myers Symposium on Cancer Research

September 4–5, 1985

London, England, Kensington Town Hall, Hornton Street

Sponsors: The annual Bristol-Myers symposium is part of a \$ 7.34 million programme of unrestricted grants for cancer research which Bristol-Myers has sponsored since 1977 at 15 institutions in the United States, Europe, Canada and Japan.

More than 25 speakers from the United States, United Kingdom, Europe and Israel will discuss a variety of subjects relevant to the design of more selective anticancer drugs. Among the topics to be considered are:

Does an understanding of oncogenes provide a basis for selective drug design – Targeting with monoclonal antibodies – Initiation of cell differentiation – Biochemical modulation of drug activity – Mathematical modelling in drug design and utilisation – New drugs in development.

A registration fee of £ 55, payable to “The Institute of Cancer Research: Bristol-Myers Symposium” will be charged. Deadline for receipt of registrations is 1st July 1985.
