The recipient of the Carbohydrate Chemistry Award for 1972 is Professor L. D. Hall (University of British Columbia). The award, which is sponsored by Tate and Lyle Ltd., is made biennially by the Chemical Society, London.

The Scientific Prize-Bernardo A. Houssay for 1973 has been awarded to Professor V. Deulofeu (University of Buenos Aires) for his work in the field of chemistry. The Prize was created in 1972 by the Organisation of American States, and is awarded annually to a scientist working in a Latin-American country.
