1993 Cereal Prize

The Cereal Prize, which is awarded annually by the French Cereal Organisations, rewards research results that show significant innovation in the non-food-stuff use of cereals or their co-products. The Prize (total grant of 15,000 ecus to be distributed amongst three prize-winners) will be awarded to young scientists (less than 35 years of age) from public research laboratories and institutions of higher education in the European Community.

The Prize is aimed at activities upstream of the cereal sector (varietal, phytosanitary, even cultural improvements) as well as activities downstream of this same sector – namely, new applications, insofar as the improvements and developments made are truly original, interesting with respect to the environment, offer, in the long term, perspectives for real markets, and are specifically intended for non-alimentary industrial application.
