It is one of the few independent publications available on the COSHH Regulations and is an essential addition to the bookshelf of anyone with an interest in or responsibility for safety.

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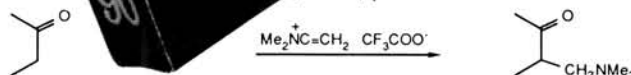
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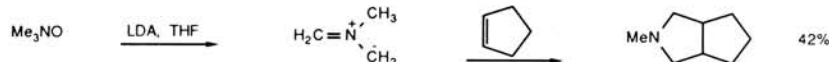
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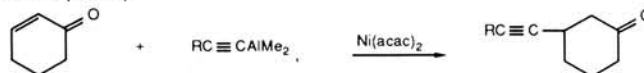
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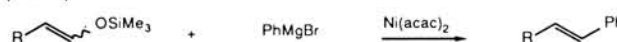
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Coupling of Grignard reagents to give biaryls: *J.Org.Chem.*, 41, 2252 (1976).

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
