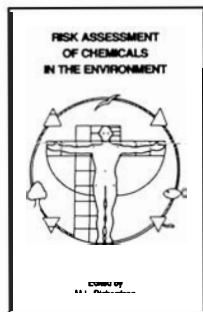


RISK ASSESSMENT OF CHEMICALS IN THE ENVIRONMENT

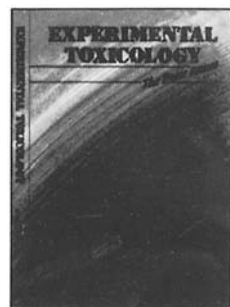

Oldershaw distilling column

Vacuum-jacketed, silvered.

Consists of sealed-in perforated plates, each with a drain tube to direct the distillate to the next lower plate. A weir in each plate maintains uniform liquid level. The jacket has bellows to compensate for differential expansion.

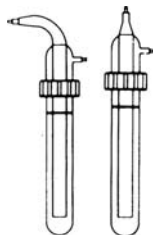
Two-piece vacuum trap

Constructed for easy removal of condensates.

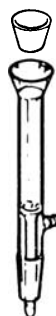

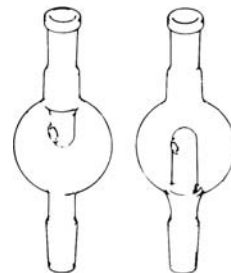
