Although the majority of articles will be specially commissioned, the Society will always be prepared to consider offers of articles for publication. In such cases a short synopsis should be submitted rather than the completed article, to The Editor, Reports and Reviews Section, The Chemical Society, Burlington House, Piccadilly, London, W1V 0BN.
