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
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Chemistry and Ecology publishes original papers, short communications and occasional review articles on the relationship between chemistry and ecological processes. The journal will reflect the fact that chemical form and state, as well as other basic properties, are critical in their influence on biological systems and that understanding of the routes and dynamics of the materials through atmospheric, terrestrial and aquatic systems, and the associated effects, calls for an integrated treatment.

Recent advances in sampling and analysis have led to the acquisition of large sets of chemical and other ecological data. Chemistry and Ecology will help to promote the ecological assessment of these data and in the development of a better understanding of ecological functions. Book reviews appropriate to the field will also be published.
