International Symposium on Electrokinetic Phenomena (ELKIN 2000)

Dresden, Germany October 3 to 6, 2000

EKP 2000 is going to continue a series of symposia that was originally initiated in Graz (Austria) and Dresden about twenty years ago and has established as the leading international conference on electrokinetic phenomena. It will be dedicated to one of its founders, Prof. Dr. Hans-Jörg Jacobasch, who died in 1998. The meeting is held now under the auspices of an International Advisory Board consisting of representatives of more than 20 countries with ongoing research activities in the field and is held in different places in the world every two years. Like the previous meetings the EKP 2000 conference is expected to become a highly distinguished opportunity to discuss both fundamental and applied aspects of electrokinetics including different systems and processes such as colloidal and dispersed systems, macroscopic sur-

faces, biological systems, geological systems, non-aqueous systems, transport phenomena in microfluidic systems and membranes, colloidal stability and flocculation, analytical separation processes. Significant progress recently achieved by application of electrokinetics in the emerging fields of interfacial forces, biomimetic materials and microfluidic systems will be mirrored by invited speakers. The programme will include invited lectures, contributed lectures and poster presentations. The organizers encourage all those interested in the meeting to make a note in their memo books right now and to have their names put on the mailing list. The conference fee (including all conference materials as well as lunch and refreshments) will amount to about DM 500. A special reduced registration fee is reserved to students.
