

Fortieth General Meeting of the Kolloid-Gesellschaft, University of Potsdam, September 24–26, 2001

The 40th General Meeting of the Kolloid-Gesellschaft was held at the University of Potsdam from September 24–September 26, 2001. It was organized by the Kolloid-Gesellschaft (H. Rehage, W. v. Rybinski), the Max-Planck Institute for Colloids and Interfaces (R. Miller, H. Möhwald), and the University of Potsdam (L. Brehmer, J. Kötz).

Richard-Zsigmondy Stipendium was given to Regine von Klitzing.

Poster Prizes were awarded to S. Eiden and G. Maret (Physics Department, Konstanz) for the poster: “Preparation and characterisation of hollow spheres of TiO_2 ” and to S. Schrage, H. Schlaad, M. Antonietti (Max Planck Institute of Colloids and Interfaces, Golm) for “Self-assembly of polyelectrolyte block copolymers into polyion complex micelles.”
