This complete player's guide is crammed with info so follow it closely. There isn't room to warn you of what might happen if you mess up. So stick with us - and stay out of trouble!

LEVEL ONE



Shoot the baddie when he appears, then jump up and collect the weapon. Drop back down and go right to collect both bottles of Nuke. Jump up and shoot the guy on the walkway. Collect the Nuke, go right, drop down and pick up the villain.

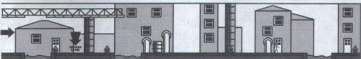
Watch out for the guy down the manhole. Jump up onto the drums. Ignore the Nuke down below and jump up onto the top walkway. Collect the first Nuke, apprehend the villain then pick up the other can of Nuke. Jump up to the next platform.



Clear the gap in the walkway, move across and collect the weapon. Drop down, move left and get the Nuke. Go right. Collect the food, then go right.

Quickly jump onto the platform and get the villain. Ignore the Nuke below and continue right. Jump up to the next platform collecting both the Nuke and the villain.

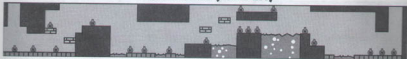
Jump up and shoot the guy on the top walkway. Jump on to the platform and get the Nuke. Edge towards the gap. Fall and pull left. Kill the baddie on this platform.



Wait until the guy has shot at you from the right. Move right and jump the water gap. Kill the baddies, collect both cans of Nuke then pull down on the joystick just before you get to the pillar to enter the secret level!

When you reappear from the hidden level, collect the Nuke and then indulge in hand-to-hand with the attacker, since there's a villain right behind him. Take a big run up for the jump over the water, and... job done! (You can't quite get that last can of Nuke.)

LEVEL ONE (HIDDEN)



The secret passage takes you down into the sewers where it's dark and slippery. Collect the three Nuke canisters, then jump up using the brick platforms.

From the large block, run up and jump across onto the first island platform. (try to check your forward momentum on landing.) Do that same again on to the second island.

Jump onto the brick platforms, then on to the top platform (ignore the Nuke). Take a running jump across the water. Drop down the step, jump the water and you're back up top.

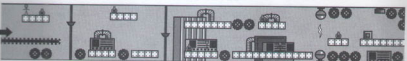
LEVEL TWO



Move straight to the first hostage (sliding over the crusher switch). Wait for the electrodes to spark twice then jump on to the conveyor belts. Let them carry you to the end then jump over to the platform.

Collect the Nuke and jump on to the next platform. Time the next three elevators. Jump on to the first and blast the baddie on the far right. Get the Nuke if you jump early enough (but beware, it's a bit risky).

Leap on to the top conveyor, drop down to get the Nuke. Drop and pull left to land on the hostage. Turn right, duck and shoot. To avoid the crusher, jump over the trip switch. Jump onto the long conveyor belt.



Hop up to the top platform, get villain and Nuke. Get on the elevator. Jump on to lower platform. Shoot the elevator baddie. Headbutt the Nuke as you jump over the blue cog.

Jump to the elevator and hop down for Nuke and hostage. Kill baddie, jump to the elevator. Shoot baddie, jump to top platform. Take a running jump over the blue cogs. Get Nuke.

Drop down, get the hostage. Wait for two sparks then jump to small platform. Crouch, blast baddie, jump across twice to avoid the slabs. Hurrah! Phew...

LEVEL THREE



Jump the gap. Jump first pair of marked slabs, get hostage and walk until the magnetic grab picks you up. You're dropped on some Nuke. Jump on the hover pad and hit fire!

The hover pad is tricky but don't panic. Get a steady rhythm to your fire button presses and slowly weave your way through the cogs. Get as much Nuke as you can.

Wait for two sparks, then get between the top two slabs. Push up and voila! Hidden-levelsville. When you reappear, turn, get the hostage, then walk over the marked slabs.



You're dropped off on a small platform. Jump to the lower platform, collect Nuke and hostage. Shoot the the elevator guy and ride up to collect the waiting hostage.

Jump across and shoot the baddie. Leap on to the next platform, slide over the crusher slabs and immediately jump onto the next platform to collect both Nuke and hostage.

Wait for the first electrodes to spark twice. Jump to the middle platform (push left in mid-jump). Wait for the last pair of electrodes to spark twice and jump to level four!

LEVEL THREE (HIDDEN LEVEL)



Step onto the hoverpad. Use lots of small taps on the fire button, rather than fewer longer ones for better control. Weave your way through the first set of cogs.

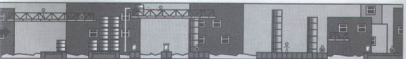

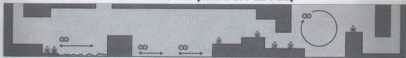

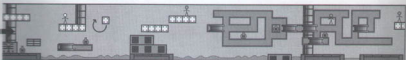

Immediately go left, face right and pull down to enter the bonus game. Otherwise wait for baddie to fire, jump the missile, land and plug him. Get Nuke and jump on the springs!

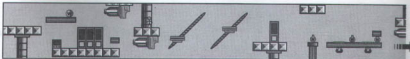

Leap onto stationary platform and get Nuke and villain. Leap right to get second villain. The last bit is dead easy so I'll leave that to you.

LEVEL EIGHT



Jump right on to top platform. Get weapon. Then duck to avoid the blast from the big gun at the top. Wait until the big gun at the bottom has blasted then drop down. Quickly move right and jump up on to the small platform. Jump up and right on to the big platform and collect the hostage.

Leap on to first diagonally moving platform. Leap onto the second one. Fire immediately. Kill ED-209 to your right. Leap onto platform where ED-209 was. Ignore Nuke. Don't stop on pillar. Jump on pillar and immediately jump off it again to the right.



Get to first magnet-free section and jump the gunfire. Take small jump right and land on second magnet-free section. Jump gunfire. Leap on small platform above right. Jump on large platform, get hostage, avoiding gunfire. Drop all the way down to bottom platform and destroy the ED-209.

Now comes another magnetic platform and crushing pillar. Drop down on to next platform, leap to the one after that (get the Nuke as you go). Time your next jump to reach sliding platform. Jump off at the top, shoot ED-209 while avoiding the gunblasts.

LEVEL NINE



Get a run up and leap right. Don't hang around. Avoid the gunfire and jump up to the next platform. Again, get a run up and leap up twice. Drop down to collect the hostage.

Wait for gunfire, dodge it, leap to next platform. Negotiate magnets. Jump twice before gunfire. Jump down to pillar. Slide immediately on to small platform.

Good timing will get you past these moving platforms. When you leap off the last one, to the top platform, get the hostage and drop down to the left to avoid the droid.



Move right. Leap gap, get up on to small platform. Keep going up to the reverse platform with ED-209 on it. Shoot ED-209 and get Nuke. Move right, jump up on small platform and duck to avoid laser blast. Shoot ED-209 from here, while avoiding laser blast at the same time. Wait until laser has fired. Leap up to top platform, move right quickly. Drop down to bottom platform. Get hostage, kill ED-209. Leap up, collect the Nuke and that's it.

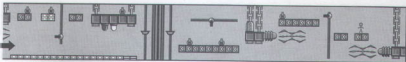
LEVEL TEN



These three platforms look sturdy enough but they plummet as soon as you land on them. Just perform three quick jumps to get across then wait before proceeding.

Move right. Duck to avoid flying magnet. Avoid lasers. When gun lines up with you, leap up to small platform. Leap over gun and on to springs and bounce over pincers.

Shoot the moving gun turret. Jump up to the top platform. Drop down on to the springs and pull right to reach the first small platform at the top.

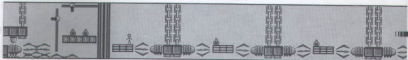


Jump on to the reversing platform. Jump immediately to third platform. When gun is level with you, shoot it. Jump right, drop down to the bottom and destroy the jet packer.

Move right until you're next to the springs, don't touch them. Do small jump right on to springs. Land on long reversing platform, wait until gun moves away and move right.

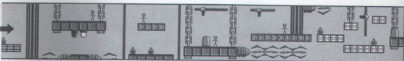
Wait for pincer to disappear, jump onto right side of its platform, avoiding gunfire. Shoot the gun, leap right three times, collecting the hostage and finishing the level.

LEVEL ELEVEN



Crouch and shoot the vertically moving laser turret. Stand up and shoot horizontal laser turret. Leap on reversing platform and edge slowly right. When magnet appears, duck out of the way.

Jump on to first set of springs and get hostage. Pull right to clear flying robot. Get Nuke from next set of springs and clear the second robot. Repeat move until you reach last set of springs. You can get across by doing quick jumps from spring to spring but you may need to bounce on a single spring to get what's there or to time your next jump properly.



Once you get up to this top platform, carefully edge along until you get the hostage. Again, edge right until the flying magnet appears and duck to avoid it.

Jump on falling platform and straight on to reversing platform and get hostage. Avoid laser then shoot it. Shoot horizontal lasers right. Drop left and get two Nukes.

Jump on pincer cases. Wait (it stops), go right, get hostage. Shoot laser, leap right, get Nuke. Drop, get Nuke. Wait for pincer to stop. Leap on pincer platform. You've done it.

LEVEL TWELVE



General advice: shoot all villains from a distance. Avoid hand-to-hand combat. Shoot balls that float down and avoid ones that float upwards.

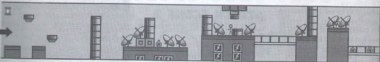
Get weapon, move right, shoot villain. Jump up quickly, get hostage. Jump right twice to get Nuke. Go right, leap up, kill villain. Drop, avoid fire and get next hostage.

Move right, kill villain, jump up to top of building and get hostage. Drop down and collect two Nukes but watch out for flames and descending balls.



Dispatch villain with due haste and jump on to crate and up on to the tall thing. When the moving platform begins its journey towards you, move right and jump on to it. As it moves right again leap on to the small platform.

Watch out for the descending balls. Quickly jump right to collect the hostage. Leap up on to the long platform and make a well timed jump on to the moving one. There's no need to attempt the tricky leap on to the second moving platform because...



...there's a building down below which is a much safer bet. As you leap off the first moving platform you can get food without falling. Having done that, do a small well-timed leap on to the third moving platform.

This final stretch shouldn't be much of a problem. Leap over the crates to get the Nuke. Leap up and collect the hostage. Move right, leap up to collect the hostage. Head down to collect the final two Nukes and you've completed the last level - but now for the really hard bit.

The final encounter

And here, at least, is the deadly Robocop 2 boss itself. In this last sequence of the game, Robocop has to face his enemy three times. Defeat the metal monster and he reappears, and each time he's more deadly, more heavily armed and more difficult to kill than the last. (Wouldn'tcha know it?)

Good thing we've got these stonking tips to help you polish off

his chromium plated hide. Follow Robocop 2's sequence of attacks as described below and take our advice on defensive manoeuvres.

The thing is, even if you do everything right first time, you're still in for one helluva scrap.



General tips on Robocopping

- It's probably best if you familiarise yourself with our directions – or get a chum to read out these tips as you go along.
- On the hover pad section (level three) use a joystick with a short button travel so you can do quick, sharp taps. This way the hoverpad moves in small amounts and is much more controllable.
- Your list of priorities in collecting things should be villains/hostages, Nuke, food, weapon power-ups, invincibility. The first two are required to complete each level, whereas the other stuff is merely a bonus.
- Take note of approaching villains. If there are criminals in the way punch them out – don't shoot. That way you avoid hitting the villain and wasting a vital 'arrest'.
- Always enter a hidden level, since that's where the bulk of the Nuke is kept. However, if you get half way and die, don't give up – you've probably collected enough to complete the level.
- Always watch the sequence of snipers and electrodes. A well-timed jump is usually enough to get past them.
- Keep your eye open for oddly patterned slabs/tiles. These are trip switches for crushers and magnets, or mark the location of hidden levels.
- Don't rush – you've got plenty of time. And practise.

Why not, exactly?
