## **German Fellowship Program**

The German Society of Biological Psychiatry will provide an additional fellowship program for young German scientists in the field of biological psychiatry. The selection criteria for the German Fellowship Program are as follows:

- Submission of the application form together with a brief letter of recommendation by her/his respective head of department/institute/hospital. The application must be received by November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2000.
- 2. Age under 35 years
- 3. Superior educational and professional record
- 4. Scientific quality of her/his contribution to the congress
- 5. Documented contribution to the field such as the list of publications or a description of other innovative scientific activities.

Prerequisite for participation in the fellowship programm is the submission and acceptance of a scientific contribution of the applicant to the congress, either a poster or an oral presentation.

The committee of the German Fellowship Program will receive and evaluate all applications submitted. The committee will finalise it's selection decisions by December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2000. By January 2001, the selection decisions will be communicated to the selected fellows.

The German Fellowship Program will comprise:

- Waving of the registration fee
- Preferential arrangement for low budget accommodation
- Financial support not exceeding DM 600.
- Invitation to become a member of the German Society of Biological Psychiatry exempted from the membership fee for one year, receiving the issues of the "European Archives of Psychiatry and Clinical Neuroscience".
