It is time that industry – especially in Europe – increases its involvement in this process.

It is our privilege to co-organize this meeting again with the European School of Oncology in Milano/Italy (ESO) as well as – and this is new – together with the European Society for Medical Oncology (ESMO) and with the European Cancer Prevention Organisation (ECP). We were unfortunately not able to have the International Society of Preventive Oncology (ISPO) joining us "on board" of this event, but we are still open for such a cooperation in the near future.

We greatly appreciate your presence in a selected audience of international experts and interested conference participants from all over the world and we hope you will enjoy the conference and your stay in St.Gallen.
