INTERNATIONAL BRISTOL MYERS SYMPOSIUM ON "CLINICAL TRIALS IN CANCER MEDICINE: PAST ACHIEVEMENTS AND FUTURE PROSPECTS"

Fondazione Cini, Venice, Italy, 19-21 October 1983

The Sixth International Bristol Myers Symposium will be organized by Drs Umberto Veronesi and Gianni Bonadonna of the Istituto Nazionale Tumori, Milan, Italy. The meeting will be directed to surgical, medical and pediatric oncologists, radiation therapists and medical statisticians. The format of the symposium will include a series of presentations followed by discussion. Known cancer specialists from the United States and Europe will critically review the design and the results of major therapeutic trials performed during the past two decades in various neoplastic diseases of adults and children. All formal presentations will be collected in a book edited by U. Veronesi and G. Bonadonna to be published in 1984 by Raven Press, New York.

Official language: English. No simultaneous translation will be provided.
