

FIRST INTERNATIONAL CONSENSUS DEVELOPMENT CONFERENCE ON GUIDELINES
FOR CLINICAL RESEARCH IN BLADDER CANCER

21-22 June 1985, Antwerp, Belgium

The primary purpose of the conference is to develop a set of guidelines for the conduct of clinical trials in bladder cancer. Participants will be scientists actively interested in randomized trials. The conference has its origins in discussion groups selected from the National Bladder Cancer Project (U.S.A.), the Japanese medical community and the EORTC. A number of topics covering the design and reporting of clinical trials, basic aspects of disease and clinical aspects of disease have been assigned to small working parties to develop a position paper on their topic. The audience is limited and reserved for scientists active in randomized trials.
