SECOND CONFERENCE ON IMMUNITY TO CANCER Williamsburg, Virginia, U.S.A., 9-11 November, 1987.

A conference to present recent advances in the various branches of cancer immunology will be held at the Colonial Williamsburg Conference Center, Williamsburg, Virginia, U.S.A. on 9-11 November, 1987. The conference is cosponsored by the Biological Response Modifiers Program of the National Cancer Institute and the Society for Biological Therapy. Corporate support includes Bionetics Research Inc., Cetus Corporation, Ribi ImmunoChem Research Inc., Abbott Laboratories, Centocor Inc., Johnson & Johnson Corporate, Ortho Pharmaceutical Corporation, Burroughs Wellcome Co., Searle Research and Development, Genetics Institute, Bristol-Myers Co., Eli Lilly Co., Hoffmann-La Roche Inc. and Stuart Pharmaceuticals. Dr. Malcolm S Mitchell is serving as the chairman of the conference. The organizing committee includes Drs. E Borden, RB Herberman, RK Oldham, CM Pinsky, MD Prager, AE Reif, R Reisfeld, S Rudnick, J Schlom and Ms. C Kirby. Five sessions of invited papers will be presented entitled: (1) Tumor Antigens and Monoclonal Antibodies; (2) Cells involved in the Immune Response to Tumor Cells; (3) Regulatory Mechanisms in Immunity and Their Implications for Therapy; (4) Biomodulation of Cancer I and (5) Biomodulation of Cancer II. A sixth session will be a workshop entitled (6) Ethical, Regulatory and Scientific Issues in Immunotherapy: Workshop on the Transfer of Biotechnology from the Preclinical Laboratory to the Clinic. Participants are invited to submit a one-page abstract, identified by session title (1-5), for a Poster Session (deadline 1 September, 1987). Early registration is suggested as the conference is limited to 300 participants.
