

Immunoenzymatic Techniques

Edited by G. Feldman, P. Druet, J. Bignon and S. Avrameas
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This volume comprises the proceedings of an INSERM Symposium held in Paris in 1975, and contains some 55 contributions. Immunoenzymatic techniques — combining the specificity of immunological reactions with the sensitivity of enzymic reactions — are being increasingly used for the localization and quantitation of biological constituents, and the papers in this book cover a variety of situations in which the use of an enzyme-labelled antibody or

enzyme-labelled antigen is appropriate. As well as considering the methodological side of the techniques, a large number of contributions discuss their use in ultrastructural localization. This volume will be of particular interest to those concerned with ultrastructural aspects of cell biology.

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
