Periodic Table of the Elements. VCH Physik-Verlag, Weinheim, Federal Republic of Germany (Order No. 10 10 109). 1986. Price: £3.50.

This useful new periodic table with all three current group notations gives the chemist great flexibility. It contains 2500 items of chemical and physical data colourfully produced on plastic-coated cardboard and is 'laboratory proof'. It also includes atomic, covalent, ionic and van der Waals' radii, abundances of isotopes and other useful information. It is clearly a valuable acquisition for schools, colleges and universities.
