

Ruzicka-Preis 1996

Aus dem Fonds für den *Ruzicka*-Preis wird in der Regel alljährlich einer jungen Forscherin oder einem jungen Forscher für eine hervorragende veröffentlichte Arbeit auf dem Gebiet der allgemeinen Chemie, die in der Schweiz oder von einer Schweizerin bzw. einem Schweizer im Ausland durchgeführt worden ist, ein Preis verliehen.

Vorschläge für Kandidatinnen und Kandidaten, die das 40. Altersjahr nicht überschritten haben, können bis spätestens 31. März 1996 (Eingangsdatum) beim Vizepräsidenten für den Bereich Forschung der Eidgenössischen Technischen Hochschule, ETH-Zentrum, CH-8092 Zürich, eingereicht werden.

Ruzicka-Prize 1996

The *Ruzicka*-Prize is awarded each year to a young scientist for his/her outstanding, published contribution in the field of general chemistry, achieved either in Switzerland or by a Swiss citizen abroad.

Proposals for candidates (age limit: 40 years) may be submitted until March 31, 1996 (date of arrival) to the Vice-President for Research at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology, ETH-Zentrum, CH-8092 Zürich.

Grammaticakis-Neumann Prize in Photochemistry 1996

In 1996, a Prize from the *Grammaticakis-Neumann* Fund of the Swiss Section of the European Photochemistry Association (EPA) – which is also the Swiss Society of Photochemistry and Photophysics (SGPP) – will be awarded to a young research scientist for excellent contributions in the field of photochemistry. The award ceremony, followed by a lecture of the laureate, is scheduled for October 1996 at the annual meeting of the SGPP.
