Helvetica Chimica Acta **2009**, 92, No. 3, p. 607: ‘Neobacillamide A, a Novel Thiazole-Containing Alkaloid from the Marine Bacterium *Bacillus vallismortis* C89, Associated with South China Sea Sponge *Dysidea avara*’ by **Lu-Lu Yu, Zhen-Yu Li, Chong-Sheng Peng, Zhi-Yong Li***, and **Yue-Wei Guo***

The sponge-derived bacterium C89 was first identified by 16S rDNA fragment analysis as *Bacillus vallismortis*. However, according to the whole genome and 16S rDNA analysis, this strain shared highest similarity with *Bacillus atrophaeus*. Hence, the strain should be renamed as *Bacillus atrophaeus* (accn. DQ091007).
