TRANSFORMATION OF INDOLE ALKALOIDS : PARTIAL SYNTHESIS OF ARICINE, RESERVININE AND DESERVIDINE

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Heteroyohimbine alkaloids, aricine and reserpinine, have been derived from an oxindole alkaloid, pteropodine, which is the main constituent of Uncaria florida Vidal. In this case, the corresponding insideheteroyohimbine alkaloids were obtained as the by-products. (Chart 1).

On the other hand, a general route was established to convert the well known antihypertensive drug, reserpine, to the congeners having different aromatic substituents. As an example, the partial synthesis of deserpidine was successfully made as shown in Chart 2.
