Editorial

Important Changes in Journal Policies

Structure Factor Tables

Inorganic Chemistry will no longer retain archival copies of structure factor tables, nor will these tables be included in the microfiche subscription to supplementary material. The Supplementary Material Available paragraph of affected manuscripts must reflect this deletion. Authors should be prepared to supply directly copies of structure factor tables upon request for no less than one calendar year following the date of publication. Consequently, readers who require these data during the aforementioned time period must contact the authors directly. This change in journal policy is effective immediately.

Three copies of the structure factor tables pertaining to submitted structure determinations reduced 2:1 or printed back to back *will still be required for purposes of manuscript review.*

Length of Communications

In order to ensure that all relevant information be included in Communications, the allowed length of these contributions has been increased from 1500 to 2000 words or their equivalent. This change is effective immediately.

Both of the policy changes described above will be reiterated in the next publication of the Notice to Authors.
