Recent developments in the pursuit of magnetic molecules and nanomagnets are highlighted in several papers: Clerac, Miyasaka, Yamashita, and Julve describe magnetic materials known as single-chain magnets, and the group of Thompson et al. discuss the use of polytopic ligands for the elaboration of magnetic grids. The topic of multifunctional materials is represented by articles describing spin-crossover metal—organic frameworks based on cyanide complexes by Real et al. and the overview written by Mathonière, Verdaguer, Sieklucka, and co-workers on photomagnetic phenomenon in clusters and extended molecule-based magnets.
