A Multinuclear (^1H , ^{13}C , ^{113}Cd) Nuclear Magnetic Resonance and Magnetic Circular Dichroism Spectroscopic Study of Thiolate Complexes of Cadmium

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Due to an arithmetic error, the ^{113}Cd NMR chemical shift given for $\text{Cd}(\text{edt})_2^{2-}$ ($\text{edt} = \text{S}(\text{CH}_2)_2\text{S}$) in Table II is too large by 1000 Hz or 45 ppm. The correct chemical shift for this species is 784 ppm and not 829 as stated under *Vicinal dithiols* (first line) in Table II. This change removes the anomaly between the metal NMR chemical shifts of cadmium and mercury(II) [1] complexes of $^-\text{SCH}_2\text{CHR}\text{S}^-$.
