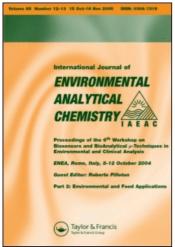

WATER INDUSTRY '81—International Congress

Water Industry '81, the International Conference and Exhibition for the water supply, wastewater treatment and river management will be held at the Metropole Convention Centre, Brighton, UK from 15–19 June 1981. The President for the first Congress, to be held in the UK, is Mr Hugh Fish, Chief Executive of the Thames Water Authority.

The Conference and Exhibition is designed specifically to facilitate interaction between manufacturers, suppliers, operators, designers, researchers and personnel responsible for water cycle management, in a single event at International level.
