## ELEVENTH INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF APPLIED MECHANICS

THE Eleventh International Congress of Applied Mechanics will be held in the "Deutsches Museum" at Munich (Germany) from Sunday, 30 August through Saturday, 5 September 1964.

Apart from a number of invited General Lectures the technical sessions of the Congress will be held in two sections, viz.:

Section 1: Mechanics of solids, Section 2: Mechanics of fluids and gases.

The Eleventh Congress will, however, not include thermodynamics or numerical methods and computing machines with the exception of specific applications to pertinent problems of one of the two sections mentioned above.

Previous Congresses have demonstrated the desirability of an adequate period of time for the presentation and discussion of individual papers. In order to allow a period of 45 minutes for each paper (not more than 30 minutes for presentation, 10 minutes for discussion, and a break of 5 minutes) a Programme Committee will make a selection from papers submitted for presentation. In case of a large number of submitted papers this selection will have to be accordingly narrow. In view of this, papers should be submitted to the "Programm-Sekretariat des Mechanik-Kongresses, Stuttgart (Germany), Technische Hochscule, Institut für Mechanik" before 1 February 1964 (except that by arrangement with the U.S. National Committee on Theoretical and Applied Mechanics contributions from the U.S.A. will be by invitation, and likewise with the exception of papers submitted by the authors from the Soviet Union for which a special arrangement has been made with the USSR National Committee on Theoretical and Applied Mechanics).

In order to facilitate the work of the Programme Committee four copies of the complete provisional manuscript or, at least, of a very extensive abstract and, furthermore, four copies of a brief abstract without formulae and not exceeding twelve lines (for possible inclusion in the programme) are requested in English or French or German or Italian. It will not be possible to consider papers submitted later than 1 February 1964.

Decisions of the Programme Committee are final, and it will be understood that it is impossible to enter into correspondence about them with authors of papers. They will be informed promptly and, if possible, not later than 1 May 1964 of the decision on their paper. Papers already presented at other meetings of a national or international character can in no case be accepted for the Congress.

It is planned to publish all papers accepted and presented in the "Proceedings of the Eleventh International Congress of Applied Mechanics". It will be possible to include improvements of papers submitted until 1 February 1964 before publication in so far as these improvements do not considerably increase the length or deviate from the original subject of the paper.

The local organization will be effected by the "Organisations-Sekretariat des Mechanik-Kongresses, München 2 (Germany), Institut für Mechanik, Arcisstrasse 21". All correspondence (apart from submission of papers) should be sent to this address. Registration forms and information on accommodation will be obtainable from this address on and after 1 July 1963. In order to ensure accommodation at Munich all participants should register as early as possible and not later than 1 February 1964.
