

## 1971 INTERNATIONAL HEAT TRANSFER SEMINAR TROGIR, YUGOSLAVIA

6-11 September, 1971

An International Heat (and Mass) Transfer Seminar is held each September in Yugoslavia under the auspices of the International Center for Heat and Mass Transfer, whose headquarters is in Belgrade. The Seminars were established in 1968 for the purpose of devoting a full week to presentation and discussion of papers and special lectures on a single subject in the fields of Heat and Mass Transfer. The A.S.M.E. and the A.I.Ch.E. were two of the engineering societies that helped found the Center; and several Americans are on its Scientific Council and Organizing Committee, the two bodies that now direct its affairs.
