

SEMINAR ON TWO-PHASE FLOW THERMOHYDRAULICS**Rome, 9 June 1972**

A "Seminar on Two-Phase Flow Thermohydraulics" will be held in Rome on 9 June, 1972.

Some among the most eminent specialists, from various countries, will illustrate some fundamental topics of two-phase flow thermohydraulics (e.g. burn-out in simple geometries; thermohydraulic codes in complex geometries; beyond the crisis point; burn-out under transient conditions; thermal-hydraulic instability; scaling of water by freon, etc.) and will give information about the most recent development of research programs; the lectures will be followed by an open discussion.

Audience is open to all people, from Research Centers,

Industries, Universities, etc.; the proceedings of the Seminar, containing papers and discussions, will be issued.

The Seminar, organised by the Italian National Committee for Nuclear Energy under the sponsorship of the "Istituto Italo Latino Americano", will take place in the Auditorium of the aforesaid Institute (EUR, Piazza G. Marconi, 1).
