INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON APPLICATIONS AND TECHNOLOGY ON IONIZING RADIATIONS

The *International Symposium on Applications and Technology of Ionizing Radiations* will be held at the *University of Riyadh, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia* on *March 12–17, 1982*. The University of Riyadh College of Sciences, with the collaboration of the King Faisal Specialist Hospital and Research Centre, invite papers and scientific exhibits to be presented at the symposium. Of particular interest are papers which *survey* an area of technology or aspect of the following topics: (1) medical applications; (2) radiation protection; (3) high level gamma irradiation; (4) radiation chemistry; (5) radioisotope production; (6) industrial and agricultural applications; and (7) dosimetry.

Copy-ready abstracts should be submitted by September 15, 1981. Review lectures on major topics will be delivered by leading scientists in the field and symposium proceedings will be published.

Partial financial assistance for travel and lodging will be offered for up to 30 speakers with outstandingly presented papers.
