Fourth Canadian Congress of Applied Mechanics (CANCAM '73)

THE Fourth Canadian Congress of Applied Mechanics (CANCAM '73) will be held from 28 May to 1 June 1973, at Ecole Polytechnique, in Montreal. It is expected that, as for previous CANCAM meetings, more than 500 engineers and scientists from North America and abroad will attend.

The main objective of the congress is to form a discussion platform for current research activities in the fields of solid mechanics, fluid mechanics, heat transfer, thermodynamics, mathematics applied to mechanics, experimental methods and unsolved practical problems in engineering and related fields. There will be a large number of technical presentations in several simultaneous sessions and also a general lecture each day by a guest speaker of international reputation. The official languages of the conference will be English and French.

Paper selection will be based on an 800-word abstract which, if accepted for presentation, will appear in the Congress Proceedings, together with the general lectures.

Accommodation for participants will be available in campus residences at the University of Montreal, as well as in hotels in the city of Montreal.
