### A Call for Authors

Contributions are solicited for the book *Computer Programs in Shock and Vibration* to be published in hard-back form by the Shock and Vibration Information Center. Although contributions on particular research results are not of interest, three types of papers are solicited:

(1) critical reviews of the available (commercial, COSMIC, etc.) computer programs to solve a class of shock and vibration problems, e.g. shock wave propagation in solids.

(2) critical evaluations of the available computer programs to perform a function, e.g. eigenvalue extraction, of interest to the shock and vibration community.

(3) papers delineating the procedure for selecting the proper computer program for a particular shock and vibration problem. For example, "How to Select the Best Computer Software for the Dynamic Response of Thin-Walled Shells".

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*In addition to soliciting authors, we are interested in receiving information on available shock and vibration computer programs. This information will be passed on to the person reviewing the programs in the appropriate area.*
