## 14th INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF THEORETICAL AND APPLIED MECHANICS

The 14th Congress will be held at Delft University of Technology in Delft, The Netherlands, from Monday 30 August to Saturday 4 September 1976. All meetings will take place in the Main Auditorium and in the adjacent Department of Mechanical Engineering.

The Congress will encompass the entire field of theoretical and applied mechanics. The Congress Committee of IUTAM will invite five speakers to deliver a general lecture, and ten to fifteen speakers for sectional lectures, all of one hour's duration. An additional number of ten to fifteen sectional lectures will be selected from the contributed research papers on the basis of their more general interest. The discussion of sectional lectures will take place in special sessions of "prepared discussions".

In order to allow adequate time for contributed research papers (30 minutes for presentation and discussion), the number of papers that can be accepted in seven parallel sessions is about 200. An International Papers Committee will be responsible for the selection of contributed papers (and from these ten to fifteen sectional lectures) on the basis of summaries submitted by authors. The last activity of each day in the parallel sessions of contributed papers is an "open discussion" of all papers presented in the session that day.

The Proceedings of the Congress will contain the general and sectional lectures. It is intended to make available to all participants, upon registration at the Congress desk, the text of the lectures whose manuscripts have been received in time. Authors of accepted contributed papers are free to publish their work elsewhere after the Congress.

The Congress fee is Hfl. 190.- (approximately \$72) for registrations received not later than 15 June 1976. The Congress fee includes simple lunch and coffee at the University. After 15 June 1976, the Congress fee is increased to Hfl. 225.- but the Congress Office cannot guarantee accommodation for participants registering after this date. Accommodation will be available in hotels in The Hague and Rotterdam (with bus service to the University) and a limited number of participants can be accommodated in student apartments and hotels in Delft.

The social program will include an excursion to Amsterdam, and a special program will be established for accompanying persons.

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Prospective authors of contributed papers should send extensive summaries in English (approx. 500 words) in 5 copies plus a brief abstract (100–150 words) to the address given above. The summaries and abstracts must reach the Congress Office not later than 1 March 1976.
