The purpose of the symposium is to provide multidisciplinary medium for communicating recent and projected advances in computer hardware, software, numerical analysis, applied mechanics and their application to future structural analysis and synthesis systems. Papers are invited on the impact of development in each of the aforementioned areas on structural analysis and synthesis. Authors should submit three copies of an *extended abstract of about 1,000 words prior to 30 September 1977*. Notification of acceptance will be given by 27 November 1977. Three copies of the *final manuscript will be due by 7 April 1978*. A volume of proceedings will be published before the meeting and the papers accepted will also be considered for publication in the *Journal of Computers and Structures*.
