

## ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR PAPERS

### SECOND ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL ROBERT J. MELOSH MEDAL COMPETITION

Student Papers are invited on all areas of finite element analysis. Six finalists will be selected by a panel of judges and these papers will be presented orally at Duke University on 17 March 1990. The winner will be selected based on the paper content and its presentation, and will receive the Robert J. Melosh Medal and a \$500 prize.

In order to be eligible, papers must be submitted for review no later than 15 January 1990 and must not exceed 8 pages in length (single spaced) including all graphics. Finalists will be notified on 15 February 1990. All papers must be by a single author and may not have been published prior to their submission to the Robert J. Melosh Medal competition.
