

CALL FOR PAPERS

IABEM 93, INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON BOUNDARY ELEMENT METHODS

Technical University Braunschweig, Germany, 16–19 August 1993

The aim of this symposium is to provide a forum for researchers in boundary element methods as well as for users of this computational methodology. The topics that will be covered include mathematical aspects and applications to solid and fluid mechanics, acoustics, heat transfer, electromagnetics, optimization, inverse problems and other interdisciplinary problems. Papers dealing with the coupling of the boundary element method with other computational methods, and those focussing on computational strategies, e.g. parallel processing, are encouraged.

Extended abstracts of approximately 500 words (2 pages) may be submitted to the Symposium Chairman, Professor Dr Heinz Antes, Institute of Applied Mechanics, Technical University, D (W) 3300 Braunschweig, Germany. The abstract should discuss the motivation for the research, the approach used, and the results obtained in sufficient detail for review by knowledge peers. Figures and references should supplement the discussion. The paper review schedule is:
