CISM SEMINAR

SIMPLIFIED ANALYSIS OF INELASTIC STRUCTURES SUBJECTED TO STATICAL OR DYNAMICAL CYCLIC LOADINGS

Ecole Polytechnique, Palaiseau, France, 7-10 October 1985

The objective of the seminar is the comparison among various existing methods which are available for evaluating the deformation and stress state in an inelastic structure.

There will be a maximum of five invited lecturers. Each lecturer will make a three-hour detailed presentation of the foundation of his method, and will give some practical applications of his procedure.

During a final discussion session, it is expected that under the guidance of a moderator, a set of recommendations for industrial design applications will be generated.
