

ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR PAPERS

THE ROBERT J. MELOSH MEDAL COMPETITION

Student papers are invited on all areas of finite element analysis. Six finalists will be selected by a panel of judges and these papers will be presented orally at Duke University on 23 March 1991. The winner will be selected based on the paper content and its presentation, and will receive the Robert J. Melosh Medal and a \$500 prize.

All papers must be by a single author, a student or within one year after graduation, and may not have been published prior to their submission to the Robert J. Melosh Medal competition. In order to be eligible, papers must be submitted for review no later than 11 January 1991 and must not exceed 4000 words (or 8 single spaced pages) in length, including all graphics. Authors should submit four copies of the paper, one with the first page indicating title and author's name and affiliation, and three copies without author's name and affiliation. Finalists will be notified on 22 February 1991.
