FIRST INTERNATIONAL AEROSPACE SUMMER SCHOOL

Dnepropetrovsk State University (DSU), Ukraine

June–July 1993

Announcement for Journals and participants

The First International Aerospace Summer School (IASS '93) will be held in Dnepropetrovsk, Ukraine, during 15 days in June–July 1993. The main purpose of the school is to study the design and manufacture of rocket and space systems and to become acquainted with the achievements of researchers and engineers from the Community of the Independent States. Participants will be able to attend the lectures of the leading specialists in the following disciplines: Missile Engineering Design; Design and Strength of Space System and Missile Structures; Probabilistic and Statistical Methods in Missile and Space System Design; Aerodynamic and Flight Dynamics of Missiles; Solid-Propellant Motors; Liquid-Fuel Rocket Engines; Electrical Rocket Engines and Space Power Equipment; Missile Manufacturing.

In addition, students will have the opportunity to examine the research base of DSU and to visit the Ukrainian Space-Rocket Center "Yuznoye" and other aerospace industrial facilities.

The official language of the school will be English. Students will also have opportunities to study Russian and Ukrainian with emphasis on the fields of their professional interest.

Location of the Summer School: The Summer School will be held in the Summer Sport Camp of the State University situated in coniferous forest, 60 km south-east of Dnepropetrovsk.

Cultural Program: Students will have a good rest and opportunities to go in for sport in their spare time. Participants can use these facilities free of charge. Cultural program includes sightseeing of historical places in Ukraine.

Admission Requirements: Participants should have completed at least two years of undergraduate studies at a university level.

Cost of the Program: The cost of the Program is US\$1,300. This figure includes tuition, proceedings, board, lodging, the cultural program and travel expenses within the Ukraine. This fee does not include round trip fare or other incidental expenses.

Application Process: Letters of interest should be sent as soon as possible, but not later than 1 December 1992 to the address given below. The second announcement with more detailed information on the lecture courses of the Summer School and its curriculum will be sent to those interested prior to 1 March 1993.

Please note, if correspondence is sent by mail the delivery may take up to three weeks.
