# INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE STABILITY OF STRUCTURES

Timing: 7–9 June 1995 Venue: Coimbatore, India.

#### Conference Theme

The increasing use of high-strength materials in recent times and the ever-present need to produce light and optimized structures, has propelled instability-buckling criteria to the forefront of structural engineering design. There are a vast number of problems currently engaging the attention of researchers such as postbuckling resistance and imperfection-sensitivity of stiffened and articulated structures, optimization under stability constraints, and the question of encapsulating the insights gained through analysis in the form of simple rules for immediate use. The main purpose of the conference is to review the current state of knowledge and identify key issues for future research. It aims to bring together experts in the field from all continents and to provide a forum for vigorous exchange of ideas. The Official language of the conference will be English.

### Call for Papers

Prospective authors are requested to submit an abstract of not more than 500 words, with five key words, not later than 1 August 1994 directly to the organizing secretary at the host institution. Accepted final papers will be due by 1 March 1995 for inclusion in the Conference Proceedings. *Engineering Structures Journal* will bring out a special volume containing selected papers presented at the conference.
